



festivities planned for the Upshur County Yamboree would meet any exception to the Governor's orders on the prohibition of mass gatherings in excess of 100 people.


**IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, ORDERED, AND DIRECTED** by the County Judge of Upshur County, Texas and the Mayor of the City of Gilmer, Texas that any outdoor gatherings in excess of 100 people are prohibited, unless the proposed gathering is specifically authorized by the County Judge in the case of any gathering of an incorporated area of Upshur County, Texas, or is specifically authorized by the Mayor of the City of Gilmer, Texas in the case of any proposed gathering which is to occur within the city limits of Gilmer, Texas.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DIRECTED** that a copy of Executive Order No. GA 28 be published on the Upshur County website and on the City of Gilmer website so that the citizens of our County and City may know exactly what is required of them.

Further, **IT IS RESOLVED, ORDERED and DIRECTED** that the failure of any person to comply with this Order and Directive commits a Class B misdemeanor punishment by confinement in jail for a term that does not exceed 180 days and/or the imposition of a fine not in excess of \$1,000.00.


