On this day came on to be considered the petition of 21 property tax paying voters of Souls Chapel School District No. 12 of Upshur County asking that an election be held in said District to determine whether an annual advallorum tax of 20 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said District. It appearing that said petition is in due form and has the required number of signers thereto; it is therefore ordered by the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, that an election be ordered in said Souls Chapel School District No. 12 at the School House in said District on the 13 day of June A. D. 1908 to determine whether or not there shall be levied annually and collected on all the taxable property in said district a tax of 20 cents on \$100.00 valuation on all taxable property in said District No 12 for the support and maintenance of the public Schools in said district. Such tax if voted, to be collected for year, 1908 and thereafter annually, unless it be discontinued by law.

W.H.Fennell is hereby appointed manager of said election and he shall select one Judge and one Clerk to assist him in holding same.

A copy of this order signed by the County Judge attested by the Co.Clerk shall serve as proper notice of said election and the County Judge shall cause notice of said election as required by law.
