(Precinct No. 1) until his successor is duly elected and qualified, upon his qualifying and giving bond as required by law.

ORDER DECLARING RESULT OF THE ELECTION- LAFAYETTE

The State of Texas,)

County of Upshur.) Whereas, an election was duly held in the town of Lafayette in the county
 of Upshur on the 9 day of May 1908, to determine if said town should form an incorporation for
 school purposes only within the boundaries hereinafter described, and returns of said elec-
 tion have been duly made to and canvassed by me, from which returns it appears that said elec-
 tion 23 votes were cast for " Corporation" and 16 votes were cast for "No Corporation":
 Therefore, I Albert Maberry, in my capacity as County judge of Upshur County, do adjudge that
 said election resulted in favor of such incorporation and I do hereby declare the inhabitants of
 said territory, hereinafter described, duly incorporated for free school purposes only within
 said boundaries, the name of the incorporation being Lafayette Independent School District.
 The Territory so incorporated is situated in Upshur and Camp Counties, and is described by metes
 and bounds as follows: Beginning in Camp County at a stake on North bank of Richland creek begin-
 ning on W.Bd. Line of A.J.Robertson's Home place; Thence North 20 W. to Prairie Creek; Thence West
 up said creek to Camp county line; Thence East with said County line to the Eastern boundary line
 of Harrison County School land; Thence South 20 East with said Harrison County Land line to
 Richland creek; Thence down said Richland creek with its meanderings to the place of beginning.

And whereas on the said 9 day of May 1908, there was also held in said town an election for
 seven trustees for said Lafayette Independent School district, and returns of said election hav-
 ing been duly made to me and having been canvassed by me, I find from said re turns that at said
 election there were cast _____ votes, of which J.W.Adkins received 30 votes, W.N.Lindsey received
 26 votes, G.W.Monts received 30 votes, C.F.Henderson, received 30 votes, L.F.Christopherreceived
 23 votes and W.J.Harrison received 32 votes.

Therefore, I do hereby declare the said J.W.Adkins, W.N.Lindsey, G.W.Monts, C.F.Henderson, L.S.Chris-
 topher, O.Lindsey, Jr. and W.J.Harrison duly elected as trustees of said Lafayette Independent
 School District. This order is made and entered by me on the record of the Commissioners Court
 of Upshur County, this the 19 day of May 1908.
