Daniels Place after a careful examination of same it is the opinion of the Court that it would be to the best advantage of all concerned for the change to be made as prayed for.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said Justice Court in and for Precinct No. 6, Upshur County, Texas, be hereafter held at said ~~W~~ B. Daniels Place until further ordered by this court.
