And it is further ordered that this Court also proceed to transact such other business as may properly come before it as the County Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, at this the regular August Term of said Court.

IN RE APPLICATION OF J J SIMPSON ET AL TO HAVE CHARLOTTE H SIMPSON, DECLARED A PAUPER. | In Commissioners Court Upshur County, Texas. August 14th 1911.

This day came on to be heard and considered by the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas the application of J J Simpson and others to have Charlotte H Simpson an indigent person and citizen of Upshur County declared a pauper and remanded to the custody and care of the keeper of Upshur County paupers.

And the Court after hearing the testimony of witnesses is of the opinion that said application should be in all things granted.

It is therefore considered and ordered by the Court that Charlotte H Simpson be declared a pauper and ward of Upshur County, to be fed and clothed by said County, and she is hereby remanded to the custody of Mrs N A Brooks keeper of Upshur County, paupers, to be cared for by her as per contract made and entered into by and between this court and M B Brooks on Dec 12th 1911, and now being carried out by Mrs N A Brooks wife of the said M B Brooks.
