It is ordered by the Court that O.C. McElrath be and he is hereby allowed the sum of One Hundred Seventy Five dollars, out of Road & Bridge Fund of Upshur County as an advancement on miles 7 & 8 of Gilmer & Gladewater road South.

IN RE PETITION J.E. GLOVER ET AL I
 FOR 3rd CLASS ROAD NORTH OF I In Commissioners Court, Upshur County, Texas
 GRACETON. I April 8th 1912.

This day came on to be considered the petition of J.E. Glover and 31 others also T.A. Oliver and 15 others praying for a 3rd Class road 20 feet in width be established in said County, having its points of beginning and termination, course and intermediate points as follows:

Beginning at mouth of lane East of Chas. Culpepper's on Gilmer and Jefferson road, and ending on Gilmer and Jefferson Road at or near L.D. Covins and it appearing to the Court that notice of said application has been given as required by law and that no objections have been filed except by A.A. Mattox who here now in open court consents that said road shall be opened up and declared a public highway in so far as it affects his land as follows to wit:

Beginning at mouth of lane East of Chas. Culpeppers on Gilmer and Jefferson road; Thence South by way of Mrs. W.J. Olivers through her farm; Thence South on land line of C.W. Jones & H.D. Knight & Mrs. J.B. Oliver crossing Gilmer and Jefferson road; Thence with land line of Hoot or Pabridge tract of land and Mrs. J.B. Oliver's and Stewart Fields; Thence West about 100 ydrds with Mrs. J.B. Olivers South line and A.A. Mattox North line along the route as the old road now runs; Thence due South through A.A. Mattox lane known as Clark land on East side of lane and Wade H. Greer land on West side of lane; Thence on South West and across a corner of 90 acres of land on J.M. Dunn Headright owned by A.A. Mattox to the South West corner of said 90 acres; Thence on South with land line of Buie & Simpson & J.L. Covin Sr., intersecting the Gilmer & Jefferson road at or near L.D. Covins, and W.F. Stanley is hereby appointed overseer for the year 1912 and ordered to open up said road as provided by law, and that he have the following hands to wit:

Billie Mathews, Alfred Smith, H.C. Jones, Ben Oliver, Joe Fields, Jerry Mathis, Henry Glover, Will Lowe, J.B. Powers, P.C. Collier & Las Covin.
