On this day came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 6th day of April 1912 in Common School District No. 49 of this County upon the question of issuing \$500.00 of school house bonds for said district running ten years, and bearing 5 per cent interest and levying a tax upon all taxable property of said district sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal at maturity, and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 19 votes, of which number there were cast:

- For the bonds - - - - - 14 votes;
- Against the Bonds - - - - - 5 votes;

And it appearing to the Court from said returns that a majority of the qualified property tax paying voters of said district, voting at said election voted in favor of issuing said bonds and for said tax, the Court does hereby declare the said tax to have carried in said district and the proposition for said issuance of said bonds to have been adopted, and that this court is authorized to issue said bonds and to levy and have assessed and collected said tax.
