Court opened at one o'clock P.M. on Monday Sept. 30th 1912 when the following proceedings were had to wit:

In Re continuance of Demonstration work by U.S. Agricultural Department and providing funds. In Commissioners Court, Upshur County, Texas. Sept. 30th, 1912.

This day came on to be considered the application of agents of U.S. Department of Agriculture for a continuation of the Demonstration work of said Department in Upshur County, and to provide funds to carry on said work. And the Court after hearing the argument of said agents in behalf of said application is of the opinion that the financial conditions of Upshur County at this time will not justify the granting of said application.

It is therefore considered and ordered by the Court that said application to supplement the appropriation by the U.S. Government's agricultural department for farm demonstration work in Upshur County be and the same is in all things refused.
