On the 10th day of November 1913, the Commissioners Court of Upshur County convened in regular session at a regular term of said court, all the members thereof, to wit; W H McClelland County Judge, J E Glover Commissioner Precinct No 1, L J Dalrymple Commissioners Precinct No 2, A Earp Commissioners Precinct No 3, W R Arrington, Commissioner Precinct No 4, being present, and among other proceedings had passed the following order;

Whereas, at an election held for the purpose on the 13th day of September 1913, a majority of the qualified property tax paying voters of Common School District No 30 of this county voting at said election, voted in favor of the issuance of the bonds hereinafter described, and in favor of the tax hereinafter levied;

It is therefore ordered by the Commissioners Court of Upshur county that the bonds of said county to be called Common School District No 30 School House Bonds be issued on the faith and credit of Common School District No 30 of said county, as established by order of the Commissioners Court of said county passed at a former date, and ratified by a general order of ratification of all existing school districts of Upshur County passed on the 14th day of May, 1903, which order of ratification is recorded in Book 3, page 393 of the Commissioners Court of said county, said original boundaries of District No 30 were changed by order of the Commissioners court, passed on the 27th day of June 1907, which is of record in the Minutes of said Court on pages 570-571 of Book 3, for the purpose of providing funds to be expended in payments of accounts legally contract in repairing and
