

NOTICE OF ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF UPSHUR.

On this the 11th day of November, 1914, this court being in regular session, came on to be considered the petition of R B Nelson, and one hundred seventy two other persons, praying that bonds be issued by said Upshur County, in the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars, bearing five and one half (5 1/2%) per cent rate of interest, maturity forty years from the date thereof, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof;

And it appearing to the court that said petition is signed by more than fifty of the resident property taying voters of said Upshur County, and that the amount of bonds to be issued will not exceed one fourth of the assessed valuation of the real property of such Upshur County.

It is therefore considered and ordered by the court that an election be held in said County, on the 12th day of December, 1914, which is not less than thirty days from the date of this order, to determine whether or not the bonds of said county shall be issued in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars, bearing five and one half (5 1/2%) per cent rate of interest and maturity forty years from the date thereof; and whether or not a tax shall be levied upon the property of said county subject to taxation for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds, and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity.

Notice of said election shall be given by publication in a newspaper published in said county for four successive weeks before the date of said election, and in addition thereto there shall be posted notices of such election at three public places in the county, one of which shall be at the courthouse door, for three weeks prior to said election.

Said election shall be held at West Gilmer, Coffeerville, Simpsonville, Rosewood, Glenwood, Lafayette, Big Sandy, Graceton, West Mountain, Grice, Bettie, Ewell, East Gilmer, Shady Grove, Pritchett, Rocky, Kelsey, Ashland, Ore City and Rhonesboro, and the following named persons are hereby appointed managers of said election;


