Be it ordered by the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, that there is hereby levied for the year 1915 on all taxable property in Common School Districts Numbers 12,23,25,29 & 42 of this county on the first day of January of the current year, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 20 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said districts, estimated in lawful money of the United States of America, to supplement the State School Fund apportioned to said districts for the support and maintenance of public free schools therein;

Be it further ordered that there is levied for the year 1915 on all taxable property in Common School Districts Numbers 2,4,8,14,15,19,20,21,28,30,43,44,46 & 47 of this county on the first day of January of the current year, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 25 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said districts, estimated in lawful currency of the United States of America, to supplement the State School Fund Apportioned to said districts for the support and maintenance of public free schools therein;

Be it further ordered that there is hereby levied for the year 1915 on all taxable property in Common School District No 51 of this county on the first day of January of the current year, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 33 1/3 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said district estimated in lawful currency of the United States of America, to supplement the State School Fund Apportioned to said district for the support and maintenance of public free schools therein;

Be it further ordered that there is hereby levied for the year 1915 on all taxable property in Common School Districts Numbers 33,35,38,40 & 45 of this county on the first day of January of the current year, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 30 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said districts, estimated in lawful currency of the United States of America, to supplement the State School Fund apportioned to said districts for the support and maintenance of public free schools therein;

Be it further ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County that there is hereby levied for the year 1915 on all taxable property in Common School District No 51 of this county on the first day of January of the current year an ad valorem

Title XXV of the Revised Statutes of the State of Texas, as amended by the regular session of the Twenty fifth Legislature, have in all things been fully complied with, and that the cash and other assets mentioned in the quarterly report made to and filed in this court by J L George County Treasurer of said County, for the quarter ending the 9th day of August 1915, and held for him for said County, have been fully inspected and counted by them at this Term of said Court; and that the amounts of money and other assets in the hands of said Treasurer are as follows, to wit;
