

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 9th day of July A D 1917, there was begun and holden a regular session of the Honorable Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, at which were presents; W H McClelland, Co Judged; L O Shockey, Com'r Pre No 1; J W Adkins, Com'r Pre No 2; A Earp, Com'r Pre No 3; A W Tucker, Com's Com Pre No 4; L A Latch, Sheriff; R M Briggs, Co Atty; D Walker, Co Clerk, and the following proceedings were had to wit;

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Court was opened at 10 o'clock A M by proclamation of the sheriff at the Court House door, when the following proceedings, among others, to wit;

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For accounts allowed at Jul: term 1917, See Minutes of accounts allowed, Book 4 pages 215-2 ___ includes.

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It is ordered by the Commissioners Court that on the 30th and 31st day of July 1913 the court will sit as a board of equalization, to inquire into the rendition of taxes for the year 1917.

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Commissioners Court sitting as a Board of equalization took and subscribed to the following oath, before entering upon their duties.

I, W H McClelland, Judge of Upshur County, Texas; L O Shockey, Com'r Pre No 1; J W Adkins, Com'r Pre No 2; A Earp, Com'r Pre No 3; A W Tucker, Com'r Pre No 4, members of the Board of Equalization of Upshur County, Texas, for the year 1917, do hereby solemnly swear that in the performance of my duty as a member of said Board, I will not vote to allow any taxable property to stand assessed on the Tax Roll of said County for said year at any sum which I believe to be less than its true market value, or if it has no market value then at its real value, that I will faithfully endeavor as a member of said Board to have each item of taxable property which I believe to be assessed for said year less than its market value raised on the tax rolls to what I believe to be its true market cash value if it has a market value if not then its real value, and that I will faithfully endeavor to have the assessed valuation of all property subject to taxation within said County stand upon the tax rolls of said County for said year at its true cash market value or if it has no market value then its real value. I further solemnly swear that I have read and understand the provisions contained in the constitution and laws of this state relative to the valuation of taxable property, and that I will faithfully perform all the duties required of me under the constitution and laws of this state, so help me God.

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BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 9th day of July A D 1917 there was begun and holden within and for the County of Camp and State of Texas, a regular session of the Commissioners' Court. Present and presiding, C E Bryson, County Judge, present and in attendance, J M Sanders, Com. Prec No One, J L Clinton, Com Prec No 2; J M Smith, Com Prec No 3 and A B Reynolds, Com Prec No 4 and J L Turnage, County Clerk and D H Carpenter, Sheriff of said County. The Court having been duly as required by law, the following orders were made and ordered entered, to wit:

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For Common County Line School District No 18 of Camp County (Dist #40 Upshur County) a tax of 18 1/2c on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said District for year 1917, for the purpose of paying the current interest on an issue of \$1250.00 School House Bonds for said District running 20 years and bearing 5% interest and to provide a sinking fund to pay the principal at maturity; also

A tax of 31 1/2c on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said district for year 1917, for the purpose of supplementing the State School Funds apportioned to said District.
