

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 8th day of Oct A D1917, there was begun and holden a regular session of the Honorable Commissioners Court of Upshur County Texas, at which were present; W H McClelland, County Judge; L O Shockey, Commissioner Prec No 1; J W Adkins, Commissioner Precincy No 2; A Earp, Commissioner Precinct No 3; A W Tucker, Commissioner Prec No 4. L A Latch, Sheriff; R M Briggs, County Attorney; D Walker, County Clerk, and the following proceedings were had to wit;

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Court was opened at 10 o'clock by proclamation of the sheriff at the Court House door, when the following proceedings, among others, were had, to wit;

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Four accounts allowed at October term 1917, Three Minutes of Accounts allowed Book Page pages 8 to 9 inclusive.

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ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS COURT ESTABLISHING ROAD DISTRICT NO 4, of Upshur County Texas.
The State of Texas
County of Upshur

On this the 8th day of Oct 1917, this court being in regular session, came on for consideration the establishment of Road District No 4, in Upshur County Texas.

And it appearing to the court that it is desirable to establish said Road district;

It is therefore ordered and considered by the court that said Road District No 4 be and the same is hereby established, with the following metes and bounds, to wit;

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Rhonesboro Common School District No 43, Upshur County, Texas; Thence down Little Cypress Creek with its meanderings Eastwardly, the said creek being the North Boundary line of said School District No 43 and continuing with said creek to the Northeast corner of said School District No 43; Thence South with the East Boundary Line of said School District to a corner of same; Thence East to another corner of said School District No 43 on the North Boundary line of the E Mora surveysurvey; Thence South with the East Boundary line of said school District No 43 to a Southeast corner of same; Thence West with the South Boundary Line of said School District No 43 at 2602 varas an "L" corner of same; Thence South at 813 varas past another South East corner of said School District No 43 and continuing South to the South Boundary Line of said E Mora survey; Thence East to the Northwest corner of the W M Calhoun head-right survey; Thence South with the West Boundary line of said Calhoun survey and the West Boundary line of the M Hunt survey to the North Boundary line of the Wm J B Ford survey; Thence East to the Northeast corner of the said Ford survey; Thence South 950 varas to the North Boundary line of Shady Grove Common County Line School District No 26; Thence East to a stake on the Boundary line of the Hazel Lathrop survey; Thence South to the Southwest corner of the John Nicholson survey; Thence East to the Eastern North-east corner of said school district No 26; Thence South with the East Boundary line of said School District No 26 to the North Boundary line of Justice Precinct No 7 of Upshur County, Texas; Thence West with said Justice Precinct to the Northwest corner of same on the Upshur and Wood County Line; Thence North with said County Line to the place of beginning.

To the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas:

We, the undersigned officers holding an election on the 10 day of Nov 1917 to determine if said county (or Road District No 4 of Upshur County Texas, as the case may be) shall issue \$25000.00 of bonds for the purpose of (Twenty five thousand dollars) erecting or building a Macadamized or graveled road, beginning at the SB line of Precinct No 4 on the Big Sandy highway. Thence in a Northerly direction via Shady Grove & Rhoneshore to Cypress Creek, also beginning at Shady Grove & running in an Easterly direction on the Gilmer Road to the Latch School Dist. hereby certify that at said election there were 32 votes cast, of which number there were cast *FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREFOR* 29 votes.
