

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT On the 4th day of August, A. D. 1919, Commissioners court met in regular session, the following members, being present, to-wit; D. Walker, County Judge, J. L. Georeg, Commissioner Precinct No 1. Jerry Dean, Commissioner Precinct, No 2. G.W. McIntosh, Commissioner Precinct No 3. A. W. Tucker, Commissioner Precinct No 4 and, G. L. Florence, County Attorney, J. W. Bryce, Sheriff, and T. A. Cook County Clerk, when the following proceedings were had to -wit;,

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It came on to be considered bids for the constructions of Four roads to-wit; Simpsonville, Coffeerville, Glenwood, and Pritchett, after tablitating the bids they were found to run 29-30 and 32 cents per yard for dirt work, which was considered by the court, to be entirley out of line, the bids submitted by three contractors on the Simpsonville road were \$59.000.00 \$60.000.00, and \$41.000.00, respectively for clearing grubbing and grading which is aproximately \$4000.00 per mile. After due consideration court decided to deject all bids. 0

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On Tuesday August 5th, the matter of letting a contract for culberts and bridges on the four roads herctofore mentioned was taken up and considered when the contracts for culberts, was awarded the Wyatt, metal works, of Dallas, Texas, and the contract for bridges was awarded to the Kansas City Bridge Companu, of Kansas City Mo.,

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It is ordered by the Commissioner's Court in Regular Session that this the August term 1919, That the County Treasurer of Upshur County shall, after the 1st day of Dec. 1920 receive such a rate of commission on all money received and paid out by him as to make a sum not to exceed \$25.00 per month or \$300.00 per year.

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
