George, Commissioner Precinct No 1. Jerry Dean, Commissioner Precinct No 2. G. W. McIntosh, Commissioner Precinct No 3. A. W. Tucker, Commissioner Precinct No 4 and G. L. Florence, County Attorney, J. W. Bryce Sheriff, and T. A. Cook County Clerk, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit;

TAX RATE OF UPSHUR COUNTY. 1919.

IN COMMISSIONER'S COURT UPSHUR COUNTY. TEXAS.
SEPTEMBER TERM. 1919. SEPTEMBER. 27th, 1919.

This day came on to be considered by the Commissioners court of Upshur County, Texas, the question of fixing the rate of taxation on each \$100.00 valuation of all the taxable property in Upshur County, Texas, subject to taxation on January 1st, 1919. the court being of the opinion that 65 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in Upshur County, Texas, on January 1st, 1919 will be sufficient to meet the demand of Upshur County for the current year 1919.

It is therefore considered and ordered by the Commissioners court of Upshur County, Texas, in special session on this the 27th day of September 1919 all the members of said court being present, to-wit;

Being present, that advalorem tax of 65 cents on each \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in Upshur County, Texas, on January 1st, 1919, be and the same is hereby levied in lawful currency of the United States of America for the following purposes and apportioned to the following funds of Upshur County, to-wit;

For general purposes and advalorem tax of 25 cents on each one hundred dollars, valuation of all taxable property, in Upshur County, on January 1st, 1919, is hereby levied.

For road and bridge purposes, that is building public roads and bridges and keeping same in repair, an advalorem tax of 15 cents, on each one hundred dollars, worth of all taxable property in Upshur County, Texas, on January 1st, 1919, is hereby levied. Tax hereby levied, road and bridge purposes, includes, special levies, heretofore made aggregating 9-1/2 cents on the One Hundred dollars, valuation set aside ^{to} pay interest bearing warrants issued and to be issued in payment for work on Public road the total road and bridge tax levy being 15¢ cents on the One Hundred valuation. For the purposes of paying jurors, in the district County and Justice court of Upshur County, an advalorem tax of 7 ¢ on the One Hundred Dollars, worth of taxable property in Upshur County, Texas, on January 1st, 1919, is hereby levied, for the purposes of maintaining and keeping in repair, the court house and Jail and for other permanent improvements, and advalorem tax, of 18¢ cents, on the One Hundred Dollars, worth of taxable property, in Upshur County, Texas, on January 1st, 1919. is hereby levied, ~~the total county advalorem tax.~~ The Total county advalorem tax, for the year 1919, being 65¢ cents on the One Hundred ^{Dollar} Valuation on all taxable property in Upshur County, Texas.

And it is further ordered by the court that one half th amount levied by the State of Texas, upon all occupation tax, be and the same is hereby levied, for the purpose of supplementing Jury fund of Upshur County, Texas, and that a per capita tax of 25¢ be levied upon all persons ~~in~~ residing in Upshur County, on the 1st day of January 1919, subject to pay poll tax, for the year 1919, for General county purposes.

For the purpose of supplementing the road and bridge fund a special advalorum tax, of 15¢ on the one Hundred Dollars, valuation of all taxable property in Justice Precincts, Nos, 1,4,7, and 8. Subdivision of Upshur County, Texas, is hereby levied for the year 1919.

It is further ordered by the court that to pay interest on one Million Dollars, road Bonds, and create a sinking fund sufficient to redeem them at maturity a special tax, of 60¢ on the One Hundred Dollars, valuation is hereby levied on all taxable property, in Upshur County, Texas, for the year 1919.

It is ordered by the Commissioner Court of Upshur County, Texas, that a tax of 20¢ on the One Hundred Dollars, valuation of taxable property, be levied in ^{Common} School District No 29. and 42. of Upshur County, Texas, to supplement the State School Fund, and for the maintainance, of public free school in said districts. It is further ordered by the court, that there shall be levied for the year 1919, on all taxable property in common school District Nos, 1,4,6,7,8,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,19,20,21,22,23,25,26,28,29,30,31,33,38, 42,43,44,46,47,48,49,51. Of this County, on the 1st, day of January, 1919, Advalorum, tax of and at the rate of 25¢ on the One Hundred Dollars, valuation of taxable property, in said District, for the purposes of supplementing the State School Fund, apportioned to said district, for the support and maintainance of public free school therein.

Be it further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1919, all taxable property in County Line District # 40(Lilly) on the 1st day of January 1919, an advalorem tax of and at the rate of 31-1/2 cents, on one Hundred Dollars, valuation of all taxable property, in said district for the purpose of supplementing State School Fund, apportion to said district, for the support and maintenance of public free school therein.

Be it further ordered by the court, there shall be levied and collected, for the year 1919, on all taxable property, in common school districts, Nos, 18,35, and 45. of Upshur County, Texas, on the 1st, day of January, 1919, and Advalorem tax, of and at the rate of 50¢ on the One Hundred Valuation of the taxable property of said District, to supplement State School Fund, portion to said District, for the support and maintainance of Public free school therein.

Be it further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1919, all taxable property in Common School Districts, Nos, 2,3, of Upshur County, Texas, and advalorem tax, of and at the rate of 30 cents, on the One Hundred valuation taxable property in said District, for the purposes of supplementing the State School Fund, portioned of said District for the support and maintainance of Public Free School therein.

Be it further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1919, on all the taxable property, common School district No 50. and advalorem tax, of and at the rate of 5 cents, on the One Hundred Valuation on all property in said District, to supplement the State School fund apportioned to said district for the support and maintainance of the Public School therein.

Be it further ordered by the Commissioners court, that there shall be levied on all taxable property in Common School district, Nos, 1,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,19,21, 22,23,25,26,28,29,30,31, 33,38,39,41,42,43,44,46,48,49,51. Of Upshur County, Texas, on the 1st day of January, 1919, advalorem tax of and at the rate of 25 cents, on the One Hundred valuation on all taxable property in said district to pay current interest on and provide one Year sinking fund for the bonds, of said district.

Be it further ordered by the Commissioners court, that there shall be levied for the

year 1919, and advalorem tax of and at the rate of 30 cents, on the One Hundred Valuation on all taxable property, in Common School District, Nos, 2 and 3 of Upshur County, Texas, to pay current interest on and provide one year sinking fund for the bond of said District.

And it is further ordered by the Commissioners court, that a tax shall be levied for the year 1919, on all taxable property, in County line district, No 40 (Lilly) of and at the rate of 18-1/2 cents, on the One Hundred valuation of taxable property, in said district, to pay current interest, on and provide one sinking fund for the bonds of said District.

A petition having been heretofore presented to the County Judge of Upshur County, asking that an election be held in School District No 9 to determine whether or not a local maintainance tax, of and at the rate of 25¢ on the One Hundred Dollars, valuation, should be voted in said district. The court now proceeds, to consider and canvas the return of said election which was held on the 20th day of September, 1919. It is found that the returns shows for the tax 13 votes, and against the tax, 16 votes. It is therefore ordered and decreed by the court, that said proposition to vote said special tax, in district No 9 was defeated, as shown by the terms, of said election.

A petition having been heretofore presented to the County Judge, of Upshur County, asking that an election be held in School District No 7 to determine whether or not a local maintainance tax, of and at the rate of 15¢ on the One Hundred Dollars, valuation, should be voted in said district. The court now proceeds, to consider and canvas the return, of said election which was held on the 20th day of September, 1919. It is found that the returns shows for the tax 44 for and 0 against the tax, It is therefore ordered and decreed by the court, that said proposition to vote said special tax, in district No 7 was carried as shown by the terms, of said election.
