

BE IT REMEMBERED That on the 1st day of October, A. D. 1919, Commissioners Court, in Special Session the following members being present, D. Walker, County Judge, J. L. George, Commissioner Precinct No 1. Jerry Dean Commissioner Precinct No 2, W. McIntosh, Commissioner Precinct No 3, A. W. Tucker, Commissioner Precinct No 4 and G. L. Florence, County Attorney J. W. Bryce, Sheriff, and T. A. Cook County, Clerk when the following proceedings were had, to-wit;

On this day came on to be considered the matter of approving the tax rolls, of Upshur County, for the year 1919, when after due examination by the court, the said rolls, were in all things approved and ordered turned over to the collector.

-----

On this day came on to be considered a petition signed by John A. Mings, and 256 other property qualified tax paying voters, of Big Sandy, Road District No 7 asking that an election be ordered for that district, to determine whether or not the Sixty Thousand Dollars, in road bonds, which were authorized, by an election held on the 5th day of April, 1919, should be voted off and abandoned. And it appearing to the court, that said petition was in due form and in every way regular, and that it was signed by at least two thirds, of the property qualified voters, of said district, it is therefore, ordered by the court, that an election be held in said road district, at the regular voting boxes, therein on the 8th day of November, 1919, to determine whether or not said road bonds, shall be annulled and abrogated said election shall be held at Big Sandy, Texas, at which voting box G. C. Ferrell, is appointed manager, and at Hockley voting box in said district at which box J. L. Dunagan is appointed manager. It is further ordered by the court that notice of said election should be published in the Big Sandy Times, for four weeks, preceding said election, and that said notices, should be posted by the Sheriff, for three weeks next preceding said elections, at three public places, in said road district.
