Whereas, on the 16th day of October 1920, this court passed an order authorizing the transfer and sale to C W Bryce of Upshur County, Texas for four road bonds Nos. 295, 296, 297, and 298 of Series F, dated June 15, 1920; and

Whereas, said bonds were delivered to said C W Bryce, under said order, which order is recorded in Vol. 5, page 535 of the Commissioners Court minutes of said County and

Whereas, the estimate on which said bonds were delivered amounted to Four thousand three hundred one and 33/100ths dollars (\$4,301.33) said bonds being in part satisfaction of said estimate.

Now therefore in view of the fact that the said C W Bryce did not get, and was not in a position to get, from the proper authorities of said county a delivery certificate for said bonds; and it having been agreed by the said Bryce that he would surrender back to the County said four bonds and take in lieu therefor the full amount of his estimate in the form of a warrant against the Bond fund represented by said bonds.

It is therefore agreed by and between the said C W Bryce, and the County represented by said court that the said bonds be and are hereby surrendered to the County, and said order above mentioned is hereby revoked, cancelled and held for nought, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to issue County Warrants, or warrants in favor of the said C W Bryce, covering the amount of the estimate above mentioned against the County Bond fund.
