

Be it remembered that on the 29th day of March, A.D. 1921 there was begun and holden a regular session of Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, the following members being present: J R Melvin, County Judge; Jerry Dean, Commissioner Precinct No. 2 G W McIntosh, Commissioner Precinct No. 3; and A W Tucker, Commissioner Precinct # 4 and H V Davis, County Attorney, J W Bryce, Sheriff; and T A Cook, County Clerk when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

On this day came on to be considered the Bond of C W Burgess for approval signed by himself as principal and the National Surety Company as sureties, and after considering same it is ordered by the Court that said bond be approved.

Gentlemen:

In order to go ahead with the construction of the road work in Precinct # 7 I will ask that you allow me an advance estimate of \$9,000.00 on this work and which I will agree to pay back as follows: 15 per cent to be deducted from each estimate allowed me on said construction until the amount above specified is paid in full, by doing this it will enable me to go ahead with said work at once.
