

Be it remembered that on the 12 day of September, A.D. 1921 there was begun and holden a regular session of the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, the following members being present: J R Melvin, County Judge; C W Jones, Commissioner Precinct No. 1; Jerry Dean, Commissioner Precinct No. 2; G W McIntosh, Commissioner Precinct No. 3; A W Tucker, Commissioner Precinct No. 4; H W Davis, County Attorney; J W Bryoe, Sheriff; and T A Cook, County Clerk, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

It is ordered by the court that the copy of the annual statement of school funds of Upshur County, for the scholastic year 1919-20 be approved

It is ordered by the Court that the tax rendition of E C Lyle for the year 1920 be reduced to \$3470.00

County of Upshur/ Know all men by these Presents:

This contract & Agreement made and entered into this the 12th day of September, 1921 by and between the County of Upshur, State of Texas, hereinafter styled party of the first part, and Pickett & DeWitt, Public accountants of Dallas County, Texas, hereinafter styled party of the second part, Witnesseth as follows:

1. The Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, hereby employs the said Pickett & DeWitt to make a complete audit of the entire county records of said Upshur County, and upon completion of said audit to submit to the commissioners Court of said County, a well bound type written report of their findings.
2. The period to be covered by said Audit shall be from the first day of December 1915 to the 30 day of November 1921.
3. As Compensation for services performed in said audit, party of the first part the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, agrees and binds itself to pay to the said party of the second part, Pickett & DeWitt the sum of twenty two hundred dollars (\$2200.00). Payment to be made on estimates approved by the Commissioners Court, the Court shall at all times retain 10% of each estimate until work is completed and final report delivered.
4. The party of the second part, Pickett & DeWitt, hereby agree to and accept employment as per the terms and stipulations provided herein, and bind themselves to begin work on said audit on or before the first day of October, of 1921, and to diligently and faithfully prosecute said work to final completion. Said Pickett and DeWitt further agree to accept Registered General Fund Script in payment for said work
5. This contract shall be binding and subsisting obligation upon all parties hereto from and after date of signature.
