

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 5th day of Dec. A.D. 1921, there was begun and holden a Special Session of the Commissioners Court in and for Upshur County, Texas, the following members being present: J R Melvin, County Judge. C W Jones, Commissioner Prec. # 1; Jerry Dean, Commissioner prec. # 2; G W McIntosh, Commissioner Prec. # 3; A W Tucker, Commissioner Prec. # 4; J W Bryce, Sheriff H V Davis, County Attorney; and T A Cook, County Clerk, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

For accounts allowed see Minut-s of Accounts allowed, Vol. 7, page 36, the same ordered paid by clerk.

There came before the Court for consideration a system for the auditor and various officers of the County, it being by unanimous vote that same should be purchased and installed and whereas, the special auditors previously employed by the Court, Pickett & Dewitt propose to do and have almost completed said work-- on motion by J Dean, seconded by Tucker all members being present and voting to have said work done, Pickett and Dewitt are hereby ordered and instructed to complete same at the earliest possible date, at the agreed sum of \$1000.00 and the Clerk is hereby ordered to issue warrants in payment thereof.

On this day came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 15th day of October, A.D. 1921, in Common School District No. 6, of this County upon the question of issuing \$800.00 of School House Bonds for said District, running 20 years and bearing 6 per cent interest and levying a tax on all taxable property of said district sufficient to pay the current interest on said Bonds and provide a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal at maturity, and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 18 votes of which number there were cast.
