

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 8th day of Jan. A. D. 1923, there was begun and holden a regular session of the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, the following members being present: S J Moughon, County Judge, J B Woodfin, Commissioner Prec. # 1; A A Harrison Commissioner Prec. # 2; J R Hinson, Commissioner Prec # 3; L A Richardson, Commissioner Prec. # 4, G L Florence County Attorney, J W Bryce, sheriff, and Ramah Oliver, County Clerk, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

For accounts allowed, see Minutes of Accounts allowed, Vol. 7, pages 96 to 98 inclusive.

ORDER RETAINING JANITOR

It is hereby ordered by the Commissioners Court that we retain Edward T Trice, as Janitor for the court house. He to receive the amount of \$55.00 per month for his services as janitor.

ORDER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR
CO. DEPOSITORY.

It is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, that the County Judge of Upshur Co. Texas, advertise for bids from banking corporations, associations or individual banks in Upshur County that may desire to be depository for county for next ensuing 2 years.

It is ordered that the tax rendition of Titus Armstrong encl⁴⁷ acres of land near Boxwood be corrected so as to be 137 acres instead of 147 acres, as assessed in 1922.

ORDER CANCELLING WARRANT No. 1086

It is ordered by the commissioners court that Warrant No. 1086, issued out of the General County Fund payable to the Road and bridge Fund, issued by order of the former County Commissioners, be cancelled and destroyed by the County Clerk, and said transfer to be null and void.

ORDERS REDUCING TAX RENDITIONS.

It is ordered by the commissioners court that the tax rendition of J W Haleell of Dallas, Texas, be reduced to an average of \$6.00 per acre for the year 1922.

It is ordered by the Commissioners court that the tax rendition of P L Fox for the year 1922, be corrected and reduced from \$3170.00 to \$2300.00, as roll of 1922 shows.

Ordered by the Commissioners court to reduce the tax renditions of G W & Walter Basgum from \$7.00 and \$9.00 respectively to \$5.00 per acre for each one.

Mrs Pearl Davis Allowance.

It is ordered by the court that the County Clerk pay Mrs Pearl Davis \$5.00 in cash today and \$5.00 in groceries which had been previously ordered.

APPOINTING CO. JUDGE PURCHASING
AGENT FOR THE COUNTY.

It is ordered by the court that the County Judge, S J Moughon, be and is hereby appointed purchasing agent for the County.

ORDER RECOMMENDING COUNTY AUDITOR.

The matter of whether a county auditor be retained for Upshur County being under consideration and the matter being duly considered a motion was unanimously adopted, recommending to Hon. J R Warren, District Judge, that the office of County Auditor for Upshur County be continued and that N M Harrison be reappointed to said office.

ORDER DIRECTING THE PAYMENT OF MONEYS
BY COUNTY TREASURER.

It is ordered by the Commissioners court that the County Treasurer will not be authorized to pay any money out of any funds without he first get a warrant for same. He shall in the payment of interest make out an account for the amount and said account must be approved by the County Judge and when the county Clerk shall be authorized to issue warrant for same.

ORDER REDUCING TAX RENDITION

It is ordered by the Commissioners court to reduce the tax rendition No. 635 Ed Myers survey belonging to W W Hawkins from \$10.00 per acre to \$6.00 per acre.

An order was passed to file a petition for stock law election for stock law election for territory comprising Sand Hill, Independant Springs and a portion of Lone Mountain School Districts.

A Motion made and carried not to consider tick dipping at present.

An order was made to grant Judge S J Moughon permission to leave the County as much as ten days during each month at his own option.

In delinquent Tax Matter.. Unknown Owner, W E Reece No. 128, It is ordered by commissioners court that sberiff be allowed \$21.25 as refund for Maberry Fees and Printing Fees.

It is ordered by the Court that the County Clerk Pay the pauper allowances, as allowed by the former court, at the stipulated times, as heretofore, and that he also pay N M Harrison's, Henry Minge, and E T Trice's Salaries at the first of each month as has formerly been the custom, until otherwise ordered by this court.

It is ordered by the court that the County Clerk shall have the privilege of employing such deputies as are necessary for the performing of the duties of his office, he to use his own judgment as to when such help is necessary.
