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ORDER DECLARING RESULT OF ELECTION

On this day came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 26 day of Sept 1925 in Common School District No. 46 of this county upon the question whether a majority of the legal qualified property tax paying voters of this district desire to tax themselves for the purpose of supplementing the State School Fund apportioned to said district and to determine whether the commissioners court of this county shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of not to exceed 80 cents on the \$100 valuation of taxable property in said district for said purposes. And it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 59 votes of which number there were cast;

FOR SCHOOL TAX..... 38 votes
AGAINST SCHOOL TAX..... 21 votes

And it appearing to the court from said returns that a majority of the qualified property taxpaying voters of said district, voting at said election, voting in favor of issuing said bonds, the court does hereby declare the proposition for the issuance of said bonds to have been adopted and that this court is authorized to issue said bonds and to levy and have assessed and collected said tax, and said tax is now here levied for year 1925.

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IT IS ORDERED by the Commissioners Court that the valuation of 170 acres on Abstract No 5, M H Pulvador be reduced from \$10.00 per acre to \$6.00 per acre for the year 1924. James Snow Estate.

That 122 acres on Jno Lowery Abstract No. 273 be reduced for the year 1921 1922, 1923, 1924 to \$5.00 per acre for Mrs H L Sewell.

That 190 acres on Abstract No 89 P L Clower and 130 acres on Abstract No 300, S McCullough be reduced to \$5.00 per acre for 1923, C T Crosby

That 318 acres on Abstract No 513 Wm Whitaker be reduced to \$5.00 per acre for 1923, 1924 and 1925. Gordon Alvis.

It is ordered that \$5.17 be refunded to O T Craig on 1917 taxes.

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PETITION FOR PUBLIC ROAD

The State of Texas
County of Upshur

To the Honorable Commissioners court of Upshur County Texas.

We, the undersigned citizens, free holders, residing in the precincts through which the following described proposed road will run, pray that a public road of the third class twenty feet in width, be established in said County, having its points of beginning and ending as follows:

FIELD NOTES:

Beginning at the East side of the Jefferson Highway and about one quarter of a mile East of the town of Bettie. Thence East along the line of L E Stracener and A H Vick; Thence along the line of the tract of land owned by Mr I N Anderson on the N and also a tract of land owned by Mann Parish on the N and by L E Stracner on the S; Thence across a block of land owned by A N Vick. Thence on East across the tract of land owned by O H Brewer; Thence in a Northeasterly direction across a block of land owned by Joe Fort; Thence in a northeasterly direction along the line of Geo Cranville and others to to a point in the public road near Dick Farmer's house and about one mile West of Quinn's gin. Said road to be about two miles and one half in length.

And your petitioners ask that a jury of View be appointed to lay out and mark and establish said road and to assess damages.
