ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT CONSOLIDATING DISTRICTS

THE STATE OF TEXAS |
COUNTY OF UPSHUR |

IN THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF
UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS

On this the 12th day of April A. D. 1926, the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, convened in regular session the following members thereof, to-wit: S. J. Moughon, County Judge, J. B. Woodfin, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1, S. G. Newsome, Jr. Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, J. R. Hinson, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, and L. A. Richardson, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4, being present, and among other proceedings, passed the following order:

WHEREAS, at an election held on the 3rd day of April A. D. 1926, for the purpose of voting on the consolidation of School Districts Nos. 18 and 20, of said County, a majority of the legally qualified resident voters at Indian Rock Common School District No. 18 of said County as established by order of the Commissioners' Court on July 5th, 1904, and field notes describing same, recorded in Volume 3, page 475, of Minutes of said Court, voted in favor of consolidating the said Indian Rock Common School District No. 18 of said County, with New Bethelhem Common School District No. 20, for school purposes; and

WHEREAS, at an election held on the 3rd day of April, 1926, for the purposes of voting on the consolidation of School Districts Nos. 18 and 20, of said County, a

majority of the legally qualified resident voters at New Bethlehem Common School District No. 20 of said County as established by order of the Commissioners Court on the 14th day of May, 1903, and recorded in Volume 3, page 397, Minutes of said Court and as re-defined by the County Board of School Trustees in regular session on the 26th day of July, 1919, and recorded in Volume 1, page 56 of the Minutes of said County Board of Trustees, voted in favor of consolidating the said New Bethlehem Common School District No. 20, of said County, with Indian Rock Common School District No. 18, of said County for school purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS THAT, in accordance with Chapter 65 of the General Laws passed by the Thirty-Sixth Legislature of the State of Texas, at its Second Called Session in 1919, and in accordance with Article 2806 Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, and the Constitution and laws of said State, Indian Rock Common School District No. 18, of said County and New Bethlehem Common School District No. 20 of said County, shall hereafter be known as Consolidated Common School District No. 18, and is by this order established with the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Field Notes for Indian Rock Consolidated Common School District No. 18, Upshur County, Texas. Beginning at the most eastern North East corner of School District No. 21, known as Glenwood Common School District, a stake on the county line between Upshur and Gregg Counties and on the South Boundary line of the M. Irwin survey; Thence with said County line N 32 E 6800 vrs to a corner of said common county line in Prairie Creek at an old road crossing on said creek; Thence down said creek with its meanderings, same being the county line between said Upshur and Gregg Counties, the general course of which is about N 80 E 2700 vrs to where said Prairie Creek empties into Little Cypress Creek, said Junction being within John Lout Headright survey; Thence up said Little Cypress Creek with its meanderings N 45 W 1150 vrs to North West corner of Earnest Fenlow's 320 acre tract on said Lout survey; Thence continuing up said creek N 68 W 1400 vrs to a point due South on the South East corner of the Daniel Smith survey; Thence continuing with the meanderings of said Cypress Creek S 81 W 1425 vrs to East boundary line of the Thos. J. McKee survey, at a point 240 vrs North of McKee's South east corner and James Scott Southwest corner; Thence continuing up said creek about N 85 W 1250 vrs a bend in said creek; Thence running northwardly with meanderings of said creek N 3 W about 1500 vrs the North boundary line of said Thos. J. McKee survey and the south boundary line of John Lout survey; Thence continuing with said creek about N 80 W 950 vrs the East boundary line of John Denson Headright survey; Thence Northwestwardly with said creek and its meanderings at about 950 vrs cross the north boundary line of said Denson survey near the Southeast corner of the Wm. Ridgeway survey, and continuing northwestwardly about 900 vrs with said creek and about N 60 W with said creek 1500 vrs the Southwest corner of the L S Von Roeder survey on the North bank of said creek, and continuing with the meanders of said creek about S 47 W 750 vrs the East boundary line of the Wm. G. Norton survey, and continuing with said creek and its meanders the general course of which is N 75 W at 900 vrs cross the North boundary line of said Norton survey and at 1500 vrs bend in said creek; Thence N 33 W at 250 vrs pass the southeast corner of Wm. Johnson headright survey; Thence continuing with said creek the general course of which is N 52 W 1700 vrs to the Northwest corner of said Wm. Johnson survey; Thence about North with said creek 500 vrs the east boundary line of D R Cannon survey; Thence continuing with said creek and its meanders N 70 W 1550 vrs to where said creek crosses the North line of said Cannon Survey 375 vrs East of Cannons Northwest corner; Thence continuing up said creek with its meanderings, the general course of which is N 550 vrs; Thence N 55 W 2000 vrs the west boundary line of the J W Gleghorn survey and the East boundary line of the James Callicut headright survey; Thence N 3 W with meanderings of said creek 1600 vrs the north boundary line of the Wm. Bratton survey; Thence about N 87 W 1625 vrs to where said Cypress

Creek crosses the north boundary line of the T N Jones headright survey, said North boundary line of said Jones survey crosses Little Cypress Creek seven times in the 1625 vrs; Thence continuing with meanderings of said creek N 25 W 550 vrs to where said Cypress Creek crosses the West boundary line of the R T D Brittain survey and the East boundary line of the P H Carpenter survey, 600 vrs North of P H Carpenter's Southeast corner; Thence continuing with the meanderings of said Cypress Creek about S 72 W 470 vrs to the West boundary line of said P H Carpenter survey and 1450 vrs North of the Southeast corner of M. Ward headright survey; Thence continuing up said Little Cypress Creek, the general course of which is about N 200 vrs N 85 W 650 vrs; Thence continuing with said Creek S 65 W 800 vrs to North east corner of Gilmer Independent School District, being the original Northwest corner of Indian Rock School District No. 18, same being about 240 vrs East and 430 vrs North of the Southwest corner of said Wm. Ward headright survey; Thence South with said Gilmer Independent School District line at 430 vrs pass the south boundary line of said Ward survey and the north boundary line of John J. Hooper survey and at 2920 vrs cross the south boundary line of said J J Hooper and the North boundary line of Block No. 2, of a subdivision of the M F Flores league and labor survey, at 7975 vrs cross the south boundary line of said M F Flores survey and the North boundary line of the M. Del P. Torres League and Labor survey and at 10905 vrs the original southwest corner of Indian Rock School District No. 18 on Clear Creek, same being 1750 vrs East of the West boundary line of said Torres league and labor survey; Thence down said Clear Creek with its meanderings, the general course of which is N 87 E at 3550 vrs cross the east boundary line of Block No. 5 of said Torres survey and the West boundary line of the Jeremiah Day headright survey at 275 vrs South of Day's north west corner and continuing with said creek, the general course of which is East 1200 vrs to a bend in said creek; Thence North with same 1275 vrs cross the north boundary line of said Day survey and the south boundary line of the Wm. H. Williams headright survey; Thence with said creek, the general course of which is N 82 E 2100 vrs to a bend in said creek; Thence continuing with said creek, the general course of which is N 4 E 520 vrs to the north west corner of the W A McClanahan survey and the Southwest corner of Samuel McCulloch survey, said corner being in said creek; Thence continuing with said creek and its meanders, the general course of which is N 66 E 1125 vrs cross the East boundary line of said McCulloch survey and the West boundary line of Presley Maulding survey, about 140 vrs North of Presley Maulding south west corner and at a road crossing; Thence with the meanderings of said Clear Creek, which is very crooked, with many short turns and crooks, but the general course of which is N 83 E 1880 vrs to where said Creek crosses the east boundary line of said Maulding survey and the west boundary line of the John Denson survey, 176 vrs North of the North west corner of Hugh Brawley's 145 acre tract on said Denson survey; Thence continuing with said creek and its meanderings, the general course of which is N 85 E 450 vrs to the Junction of Clear Creek and Bog Creek, same being the north east corner of Glenwood Common School District No. 21; Thence up Bogg Creek with its meanders, the general course of which is S 58 E 87, S 37 E 92, S 13 E 100, S 25 E 105, S 18 E 154, S 50 E 77, S 46 E 59, S 3 E 72, S 5 W 72, S 10 E 156, S 35 E 108, S 34 W 84, S 11 E 58, S 86 E 52, S 6 E 192, S 9 E 360, S 24 E 165, S 10 W 191, S 53 W 83, S 30 W 90, S 40 W 72, S 56 W 36, S 87 W 28, S 55 W 36, S 69 W 72, S 33 W 61, S 8 W 63 S 22 E 68, S 6 E 95, S 38½ W 88, S 77 W 65, S 63 W 108, S 36 W 61, S 14 W 198, S 17 W 144, S 21 W 130, S 9 W 108, S 3 E 108, S 8 E 409, S 40 W 206, S 8 W 108, S 38 W 144, S 11 W 58, S 72 S 24 W 216 and S 85 W 375 vrs to a sweet gum for corner on north bank of said creek; Thence South at 900 vrs pass the N W Corner of Jackson Crouch survey and continuing South with the West line of same at 2202 vrs an el corner of same; Thence West 14 vrs another corner of same; Thence South with said line at 1362 vrs the S W Cor of said Jackson Crouch survey; Thence East at 1323 vrs the S E Corner of said survey in the East line of a survey in the name of M.
