ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS.

The State of Texas.
County of Upshur.

On this the 12 day of June 1926, the commissioners court of Upshur County convened in regular session, all the members thereof,

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being present, and, among other proceedings, passed the following order:

Whereas, at an election held for the purpose on the 22 day of May 1926, a majority of the qualified property taxpaying voters of Common County Line School District No. 18 of the counties of Camp and Upshur, Texas, having at said election voted in favor of the issuance of the bonds hereinafter described and in favor of the tax hereinafter levied:

Therefore, be it ordered by the commissioners court of Upshur County:

-I-

That the bonds of said district to be called "Common County Line School District No. 18 Schoolhouse Bonds" be issued on the faith and credit of said Common County Line School District No. 18 of said counties, for the purpose of constructing and equipping a public free school building of wooden material within said district.

-II-

Said bond shall be numbered consecutively from one to three inclusive, shall be of the denomination of \$200 each aggregating \$600.

-III-

They shall be dated July 10th, 1926, shall become due and payable 20 years from their date, but may be redeemed at the pleasure of said district at any time after 5 years from their date.

-IV-

They shall bear interest at the rate of 5 per cent per annum, payable annually on July 10th each year.

-V-

Principal and interest shall be payable upon presentation and surrender of bonds or proper coupons in lawful money of the United States at the office of the Treasurer of the State of Texas at Austin, Texas or office of county Treasurer of Camp County, Texas, or at American Exchange National bank in the city of Dallas, State of Texas at the option of the holder.

-VI-

Said bonds shall be signed by the county judge of Camp county, countersigned by the county clerk of Camp county, and registered by the county treasurer of Camp county, and the

seal of the commissioners court of Camp county shall be impressed upon each of them; the facsimile signatures of the county judge and county clerk of said county may be lithographed on the coupons.

-VII-

The form of each of said bonds shall be substantially as follows:

COUNTIES OF CAMP AND UPSHUR,

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the counties of Camp and Upshur, in the State of Texas, for and on behalf of Common County Line School District No 18 of Camp and Upshur counties, hereby promise to pay to bearer 20 years from date hereof the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollars in lawful money of the United States of America, together with interest thereon from the date hereof, at the rate of five per cent per annum, payable on the 10th day of July of each year, principal and interest payable upon presentation and surrender of bond or proper coupon at the office of the Treasurer of the State of Texas, at Austin, Texas, or office of county treasurer of Camp county, Texas, or at American Exchange National Bank, in the city of Dallas, State of Texas at the option of the holder.

This bond is one of a series of 3 bonds, numbered consecutively from one to three inclusive, of the denomination of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars, each aggregating Six Hundred (\$600.00) dollars, issued by the commissioners courts of Camp and Upshur counties, in the State of Texas, on the faith and credit of Common County Line School District No. 18 of said counties, for the purpose of constructing and equipping a public free school building of wooden material in and for said Common County Line School District No. 18, under and by virtue of Chapter 13 Title 49, R. S. 1925 and the Constitution and laws of said State and in pursuance of an order passed by the commissioners court of Camp county, which order is of record in the minutes of said court and in pursuance of an order passed by the commissioners court of Upshur county which order is of record in the minutes of said Court.

The said Common County Line School District No 18 has and hereby reserves the right to redeem this bond at any time after 5 years from its date by paying principal and accrued interest, and, in case the same shall be called in for redemption before maturity, notice thereof in writing shall be given by the President of the District Trustees of said Common County Line School District No. 18 to the county treasurer of Camp county, at least thirty days before the date fixed for redemption, and, should this bond not be presented for redemption, it shall cease to bear interest from and after the date so fixed for redemption.

The date of this bond, in conformity with the order last above mentioned, is 10th day of July 1926.

AND IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED that all acts, conditions and things required to be done and performed precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have been properly done and performed and have happened in due and regular time, form and manner as required by law, and that the amount of this issue of bonds does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.

This bond is executed on behalf of both Camp and Upshur counties. It is signed and executed by the County Judge of Camp county, is countersigned by the county clerk of said county and registered by the county treasurer of said county by virtue of authority given in the order of the commissioners court of Upshur County authorizing the issuance of bonds.

In testimony whereof, said commissioners court of Camp county has caused the seal of said court to be affixed hereto and this bond to be signed by the county judge and counter-

signed by the county clerk of said county as of the day and year last aforesaid.

-IX-

It is further ordered by the court that to pay the interest on said bond and to discharge the bonds as they mature, a tax of and at the rate of 20 cents of the \$100.00, valuation of all taxable property in said Common County Line School District subject to taxation for this purpose, shall be annually levied on said property and annually assessed and collected until said bonds and all interest thereon are paid, and said tax is now here levied on said property for the year of 1926 and for each succeeding year while said bonds or any part thereof are out-standing and unpaid, and the same shall be assessed and collected for the current year and annually thereafter and applied to the purpose named.

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON OCTOBER 30th 1926, COMMISSIONERS COURT CONVENED IN SPECIAL SESSION.

Among other things was considered the approving of the Tax Rolls of Upshur County after due deliberation and examination the Rolls were approved.

Ordered by the Court that Arthur Winston be paid \$5.00 per month commencing Nov. 1st as aid to care for his mother, to keep her from being a County Pauper.
