

PETITION FOR A PUBLIC ROAD

To the Honorable Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas;

We, the undersigned, are freeholders, residing in the precincts through which the following described proposed Road will run, due notice of same having been posted as required by law, pray that a Public Road of the 2nd Class, 30 feet in width, be established in said County, having its points of beginning and termination, course and intermediate points as follows:

Commencing at Brooks Bridge via Robertson's farm, Owen's farm, Given Moore's farm and ending at Eliza Reed's intersecting Gilmer road in Precinct No 1 the whole distance being 2 1/2 miles; and your Petitioners pray that a Jury be appointed to lay out and survey said Road, and to assess damages. And your petitioners will ever pray, etc.
