On this the 17th day of July, 1929, the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County convened in regular session at a Special meeting of the Court with the following members present:

It is ordered by the court that the T & P Ry Co. taxes be assessed at a rate of \$1100.00 per mile.

On this the 12 day of August A.D. 1929 came on to be considered by the commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, the question of fixing the rate of taxation on each \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in Upshur County, Texas, subjects to taxation on the first day of January 1928. and the Commissioners Court being of the opinion that a levy of 70 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in Upshur County on January 1st 1929 will be sufficient to meet the demands of the county for the current year. It is therefore considered & order by the commissioner's Court of Upshur County Texas, in regular session of this 12 day of August 1929, all members of said court being present to. witt: Gus Morris; County Judge; Carroll Robertson, Commissioner precinct No 1; J.M. Moon, Commissioner precinct No. 3; Geo Hart Commissioner precinct No. 4; That an advalorum tax of and at the rate of \$.70 on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in Upshur County Texas on January 1st 1929 be and the same is hereby levied in lawful currency of the U.S. of America for the following purposes & apportioned to the following funds of Upshur County, to-witt:

For general purposes and advalorum tax of and at the rate of twenty-five cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in Upshur County, Texas on January 1st, 1929 is hereby levied, of twenty-five cents general purposes tax here levied 4.1 cents is set aside to take care of certain outstanding warrants heretofore issued leaving 20.9 cents available for general purposes.

For road & Bridge purposes, that is: for building public roads & Bridges & keeping same in repair, an advalorum tax of & at the rate of 15 cents on each \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in Upshur County Texas, on January 1st, 1929 is hereby levied of the 15 cents road & Bridge tax here levied 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ cents is set aside to take care of certain outstanding warrants issued and 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ cents is set aside to take care of certain outstanding warrants issued to C.W. Burgess for highway purposes, leaving 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ available for road & Bridge purposes.

For the purpose of pay the jurors in the District, County and Justice Court of Upshur County, Texas, an advalorem tax of and at the rate of 10 cents on the \$100.00 worth of taxable property in Upshur County Texas on January 1st 1929 is hereby levied.

For the purpose of maintaining improving furnishing and keeping in repair the Court House and Jail and for other permanent improvements an advalorem tax of and at the rate of 20 cents on the \$100.00 worth of taxable property in Upshur County Texas on January 1st 1929 is hereby levied. And it is further ordered by the court that one half of the amount levied by the state of Texas upon all occupation tax be and the same is hereby levied for the purpose of supplementing the Jury fund of Upshur County Texas, and that a percapita tax of 25 cents be levied upon all persons residing in Upshur County on the first day of January, 1929, subject to poll tax for the year 1929 for general county purposes.

For the purposes of supplementing the road and bridge fund a special advalorum tax of and at the rate of 15 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in Upshur County, Texas, is hereby levied for the year 1929.

It is further ordered by the court that to pay interest on the Million Dollars road bond and create a sinking fund sufficient to redeem them at maturity a special tax of and at the rate of \$1.20 on the One Hundred Dollars valuation is hereby levied on all taxable property in Upshur County, Texas, for the year 1929.

It is ordered by the commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, that a tax of and at the rate of 25 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property be levied for the year 1929, in Common School Districts Nos 7, 10, 24, 41, 50 to supplement the State school

fund apportioned to said districts for the maintenance of public free schools in said districts.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1929 on all taxable property in school districts Nos 1, 2, 8, 16, 25, 26 & 30, 36, 39, 43, 44, 49 on the first day of January 1929 an tax of and at the rate of 50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property for the year, 1929, to supplement the state school fund apportioned to said District for the maintenance of public free schools in said districts.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied and collected for the year 1929, on all taxable property in common school districts Nos 13 of Upshur County, Texas, on the first day of January 1929, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 55 cents on the \$100.00 valuation to supplement the state school funds apportioned to said Districts for the support and maintenance of public free schools therein.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1929, on all taxable property in school district No 40 on the first day of January 1929, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 81½ cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property of said district for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund apportioned to said district for the maintenance of public free schools therein.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1929, on the taxable property of school districts Nos 6, 14, 22, 23, 31, 42, 70 (County Line) on the first of January 1929, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 75 cents on the \$100.00 valuations of all taxable property of said district for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund apportioned to said district for the maintenance of public free school therein.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1929 on all taxable property in school district Nos 12, 21, 45¹⁹ on the first day of January, 1929, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of \$1.00 on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property of said district for the purpose of supplementing the state School Fund apportioned to said district for the maintenance of public free schools therein.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year, 1929, on all taxable property in school districts nos. 3 on the first day of January, 1929, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 65 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property of said district for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund apportioned to said district for the maintenance of public free schools therein.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1929 on all taxable property in school districts Nos 3, & 48 on the first day of January 1929, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 60 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property of said districts for the purposes of supplementing the state school fund apportioned to said districts for the maintenance of public free schools therein.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1929, on all taxable property in school district No 18, on first day of ~~the~~ January 1928, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 70 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property of said district for the purpose of supplementing the state school fund apportioned to said district for the maintenance of public free school therein.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied for the year 1929, on all taxable property in school districts Nos 1, 6, 7, 8, 13, 16, 31, 39, 42, 43, 39, 70 (County Line) of Upshur County on the first day of January 1929, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of 25 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said districts to pay current interest on and provide one years sinking fund for the bonds of said dis-

tricts.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied on all taxable property in common school district No 3 of Upshur County Texas on the first day of January 1929, an advalorum tax of and at the rate of 20 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said district.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied on all taxable property in Common School district No 4 of Upshur County, Texas, on the first day of January 1929, an advalorum tax of and at the rate of 35 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said district to pay current interest on and provide one years sinking fund for the bonds of said district.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied on all taxable property in common school district No 18 of Upshur County, Texas, on the first day of January 1929 an advalorum tax of and at the rate of 05 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said district to pay current interest on and provide one years sinking fund for bonds of said district.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied on all taxable property in common school district Nos 2,24,25,30,36,41,44,50, Upshur County, Texas, on the first day of January 1929, as advalorum tax of and at the rate of 50 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said district to pay current interest on and provide one years sinking fund for the bonds of said districts.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied on all taxable property in Common school district No 40 of Upshur County, Texas, on the first day of January 1929, an advalorum tax of and at the rate of 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said district to pay current interest on and provide one years sinking fund for the bonds of said district.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied on all taxable property in common school district No 48 of Upshur County, Texas, on the first day of January 1929, an advalorum tax of and at the rate of 15 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property in said district to pay current interest on and provide one years sinking fund for the bonds of said district.

It is further ordered by the court that there shall be levied on all taxable property in Common School district No 26 of Upshur County, Texas, on the first day of January, 1929, an advalorum tax of and at the rate of 30 cents on the \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property on and provide one years sinking fund for the bonds of said district.

It is further ordered by the commissioners Court of Upshur County Texas that all taxes herein levie for whatsoever purposes shall be collected in Lawful currency of the United States of America.
