

On this the 13 day of Feb. 1933, came on to be heard before the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, the petition of the United Gas Public Service Company for permission to construct, maintain and operate a system of pipe lines, together with the necessary telegraph and telephone lines upon, across, over and under the public roads and highways of said County under and by virtue of that certain franchise heretofore granted by said County to Magnolia Gas Company on the 14th day of February 1927, which has been heretofore assigned and transferred by Magnolia Gas Company to the United Gas Public Service Company, together with the pipe lines and telegraph and telephone lines heretofore constructed under said franchise; and the Court having heard and considered the same and being of the opinion that said petition should be granted;

IT IS ORDERED that said United Gas Public Service Company its successors and assigns be and it is hereby permitted to construct, maintain and operate, under that certain franchise heretofore granted to Magnolia Gas Company by this Court on the 14th day of February 1927, and which has been assigned to United Gas Public Service Company, its said pipe lines for the transportation of oil, gas and/or other substances upon, across, over and under the public roads and highways and public places in said County and also all necessary or proper telegraph and telephone lines to be used in connection with its said pipe lines and to operate and maintain the same so long as they are used for the corporate purposes of said Company, its successors and assigns; provided that such lines are to be constructed and such improvements made in such manner as to interfere as little as possible with the use of such roads by the public and that said Company shall at all times conform to the reasonable orders of this Court in the construction, maintenance and operation of said lines.

 MONDAY FEBRUARY 6, 1933.

The Commissioners Court met in Called Session, with County Judge, J. R. Hinson, Commissioners, E.A. Cobb, M.F. Robinson, M.O. Holmes and J. P. Davis, in attendance.

Motion made by Commissioner Cobb that the rendition of R.M. Brawley, on 60 acres in the J. Crouch Survey be reduced to the same value as in 1931, \$5.00 per acre the value being reduced from the valuation made by the special oil valuation assessor and at the request of the special assessor. The reasons for granting this reduction are as follows: Failure of County Clerk to issue mail notice as required by law, and because of an erroneous condition as to fact by the special oil valuation assessor. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Robinson, and was unanimously carried.

Motion made by Commissioner J.P. Davis that the former motion made and carried January 9th dispensing with the services of the County Agent be rescinded and that he be allowed a salary of eight hundred dollars annually was seconded by Commissioner Cobb. The motion failed to carry, Commissioner Davis voting for the motion and Commissioner's Robinson Cobb and Holmes voting against the motion.

Motion made by Commissioner Davis that the County Agent be retained for the year 1933, was seconded by Commissioner Cobb and failed to carry, Commissioner Davis voting aye and Commissioners Cobb, Robinson and Holmes voting No.

Motion made by Commissioner Davis that the services of the County Home Demonstration Agent for the year 1933 be retained and that Upshur County pay Four Hundred Dollars of her

salary, was seconded by Commissioner Cobb, Commissioners Cobb and Davis voted aye, Commissioners Robinson and Holmes voted No. County Judge Hinson voted for the motion and declared it carried. It was agreed that the salary was to begin February 1, 1933.

Motion made, seconded and carried that County Clerk issue warrant on General Fund to W. G. Wilson for audit of County Books for \$600.00

Cobb, Commissioners Cobb, Davis and Robinson, voted for the motion, Commissioner Holmes Not voting. The motion was declared carried.
