The necessary notice of the application to the court was made,

Because of an erroneous condition as to fact in assessment, motion made seconded and carried that the Gid Rash Est. tax be reduced on valuation for the year 1933, as follows: 53 acres S McCollough Survey from \$860.00 to \$410.00 and 52 acres E.N. Eubanks Survey from \$860.00 to \$400.00.

The Commissioners Court in settling the condemnation proceedings against Verona Burnes, agreed to give certain parts of old Highway #155, to her if and when the new Highway #155 is finally completed East from Gilmer in Upshur County, Texas, therefore on Motion duly made by Commissioner Cobb and Seconded by commissioner Davis, it is ordered by the Court the motion being carried unanimously, that if and when the work on the new Highway #155 East from Gilmer in Upshur County is finally completed that is, opened to traffic, then and in that event Verona Burnes, will be the fee simple owner of the following described parts of old Highway #155, in the town of Ashland, Upshur County, Texas, First, BEGINNING at the East line of Lot 13 in Block 14, where said block intersects old Highway # 155, Thence South to old M & E T right of way; Thence West about 185 feet to the North line of Lot 14, in Block 14, where same intersects old Highway #155, Thence across old Highway #155 to the place of beginning; SECOND lot, BEGINNING at the N.W. corner of 5 acre tract of Mrs Rowe where old Highway #155 intersects said tract, Thence S.E. to South line of said Rowe tract along the course of old Highway #155, Thence west across said road 80 feet and touching Mrs Rowes tract of land across said Highway, Thence Northwest across Highway to the place of beginning.

To the Hon. Comm. Court, Upshur County, Texas, we Irvin Floyd; R. R. Taylor, and Nick McClelland being selected to assess damages on that part of land belonging to Evers estate, that Highway #155, passes through, after going over said property and giving same earnest consideration we believe the damage to be in amount of \$250.00 and do hereby assess said amount.

Motion made by commissioner Robinson that the automobile money of the County and all automobile money hereafter collected be divided among the Commissioners Precincts, four equal ways, the motion died without a Second.

Motion made by Commissioner Robinson that all road moneys of Upshur County, and all road money hereafter collected shall be divided four equal ways among the Commissioners Precincts. The motion died without a second.

Motion made by Commissioner Robinson, that all automobile money in Gilmer Justice Precinct, and that may hereafter be collected in said precinct be divided in four equal ways among the four commissioners precincts of Upshur County. The motion died without a second.

Motion made seconded and carried that the County Judge be given authority to purchase \$100,000.00 Upshur Co. Bonds at a figure not exceeding 94, and that he cooperate with the Co. & District Road Bond indebtedness Board at Austin and the Co Clerk is ordered to issue Warrants for same on Co Bond fund as bought.

Motion & Seconded that Co. Clerk issue warrant on Gen. Fund to Mrs. A. D. Walker for \$6.00 for March, April & May, Motion carried.

Motion & Seconded that Co Clerk issue Warrant on Gen Fund to A.J.Shelton & Wife for \$5.00 motion carried.

Motion & Second that Co. Clerk issue warrant on Gen Fund for \$4.00 to Mrs Nugget for purpose of taking care of invalid boy, motion carried.

Motion & Second that Co Clerk issue warrant on General Fund to Josie Goodson for \$7.50 per month she is now receiving \$4.50 per month, motion carried.

Motion made & carried that Co Clerk issue Warrant on General fund for \$3.50 on first day of each month to I. J. Caffey for purpose of taking care of invalid son, motion carried.
