The County Judge announced that the order had been finally passed. The order as passed is as follows:

AN ORDER

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UPSHUR COUNTY TEXAS, ROAD REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 1934-A IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,000.00 BEARING 5% INTEREST, LEAVING A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST AS THEY MATURE, AND PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF BOND.

WHEREAS, heretofore under authority of an election duly held in Road District Number One of Upshur County, bonds of said district were issued on the amount of \$100,000.00 dated July 1, 1918, of the denomination of \$500.00 each numbered One (1) to Two Hundred (200) both inclusive, bearing 5% interest, maturing Forty (40) years from date, redeemable at the

at the option of the District on and after the dates hereinafter shown of which Bonds numbers One (1) to Five (5) inclusive had been paid before April 26, 1919; and

WHEREAS, the District had the option to pay said remaining bonds prior to maturity on the respective dates as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to an election held on April 26, 1919, the Commissioners' Court did on May 16, 1919, pass an order, which was amended by an order passed June 2, 1919, providing for the issuance of \$97,500.00 of "Upshur County Special Road Bonds, Series "A" for the purpose of taking over the improved roads in Road District Number One of said County to be exchanged for a like amount of bonds outstanding against said Road District Number One; said Series "A" Bonds being dated July 1, 1919 bearing 5% interest, due 40 years after date, being of the denomination of \$500.00 each Numbered Six (6) to Two Hundred (200) both inclusive with option of redemption prior to maturity as hereinabove set forth, after thirty (30) days notice; and

WHEREAS, thereafter \$40,000.00 of said Series "A" Bonds Numbered One Hundred One (101) to One Hundred Eighty (180) both inclusive, were actually registered by the Comptroller and delivered to the holder of \$40,000.00 of the Road District Number One Bonds; and

WHEREAS, thereafter on the _____ day of _____ 19____ the Commissioners' Court passed an order, which is recorded in Volume 7, at Page 205, containing among other provisions the following:

"It is Ordered by the Court that the following unsold road bonds be destroyed:- - -

Series "A" Special Road Bonds of Upshur County From number 6 to 100 inclusive, and from 181 to 200 inclusive, said Bonds being dated July 1st 1916, 5% interest bearing, each bond issued for the amount of \$500.00 and issued for the purpose of purchasing or taking over the improved roads in Road District Number One, of Upshur County, See Vol. 5, Page 412, of the Commissioners' Court Minutes."

WHEREAS, heretofore under authority of an election duly held in Road District Number Four (4) of Upshur County, Bonds of said District were issued in the amount of \$22,500.00 dated January 1, 1918 of the denomination of \$500.00 each Numbered One (1) to Forty Five (45)

WHEREAS, pursuant to an election held on April 26, 1919, the Commissioners' Court did on May 16, 1919 pass an order which was amended by an order passed June 2, 1919, providing for the issuance of \$71,000.00 of "Upshur County Special Road Bonds, Series "E"; for the purpose of taking over the improved roads in Road District Number Seven of said County, to be exchanged for a like amount of bonds outstanding against said Road District Number Seven; and Series "C" Bonds being dated January 1, 1916, bearing 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ % interest, due Forty (40) years after date, being of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, numbered Five (5) to Seventy Five (75) both inclusive with option of redemption prior to maturity after thirty (30) days notice; and

WHEREAS, the Road District Number Seven bonds then outstanding were in the same amount were of the same denomination and had the same option dated the maturity date; and

WHEREAS, thereafter, none of said Series "C" Bonds were actually registered by the Comptroller and delivered to the holder of the Road District Number Seven Bonds; and

WHEREAS, thereafter on the ____ day of ____ 19__ the Commissioners' Court passed an order, which is recorded in Volume 7, at Page 205, containing among other provisions the following:

"It is ordered by the Court that the following unsold Road Bonds be destroyed:

"Series "C" Special Road Bonds of Upshur County, from Number Five (5) to Twenty Five (25) and from Twenty Seven (27) to Seventy Five (75) inclusive, said Bonds being dated January 1, 1916, Number Twenty Six (26) is missing, each bond issued for \$1000.00 Series "C" was issued for the purpose of purchasing or taking over the improved roads in Road District Number 7, in Upshur County, Texas, See Volume 5, Page 412, Minutes"

WHEREAS, in the respective Order authorizing the issuance of the Bonds of Road Districts Numbers One (1) and Seven (7) and in the orders authorizing said Series "B" Bonds, an option of prior payment was retained by the County; said option appears in each of said bonds outstanding in words and figures substantially as follows:

"The said Upshur County reserves the right of redeeming this bond at any time after _____ years from its date by paying principal and accrued interest and in case the same shall be called in for redemption before maturity notice thereof in writing shall be given to the holder or holders thereof by the County treasurer of said County at least thirty days before the date fixed for redemption, and should this bond not be presented for redemption, the same shall cease to bear interest from and after the date so fixed for redemption."

and

WHEREAS, of said bonds heretofore issued and delivered in accordance with law, there remain outstanding the following described bonds of said respective issues, concerning which the County now has an option to redeem same at a price of par and accrued interest, to-wit:

(a) Road District Number One Bonds, numbered and maturing as follows:

Bonds Numbers 52 to 64 both inclusive: 67, 68, 69, 71 to 75 both inclusive and 81 to 90, both inclusive, aggregating \$17,000.00;

(b) Series "B" numbered and maturing as follows:

Bonds Numbers 21 to 32, both inclusive aggregating \$6000.00;

(c) Road District No. Seven Bonds, numbered and maturing as follows:

Bonds Numbers 21 to 25 both inclusive; 27 to 34 both inclusive of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, aggregating \$13,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be to the best interest of the County that said bonds be called for redemption and the County has taken such steps as are required in said original orders in reference to calling them; and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be to the best interest of the County that said Bonds be refunded into a single issue;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court has taken such steps as are legally necessary, as required in the various orders authorizing the issuance of said bonds and as required in the bonds themselves to exercise its option of retaining said bonds prior to maturity and has given such notice as is thus required:

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That, in accordance with the provisions of Article III, Section 52, of the Constitution and laws enacted pursuant thereto, the bonds of said County to be called "Upshur County Road Refunding Bonds, Series 1934 A" be issued under and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas to the amount of Thirty Six Thousand (\$36,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of refunding, cancelling and in lieu of a like amount of valid and subsisting bonds of said County above described and more particularly described as follows:

(a) Upshur County Road District No. One Bonds, dated July 1, 1918, bearing 5% interest being numbered and maturing as follows:

Bonds Numbers 52 to 64, both inclusive; 67, 68, 69; 71 to 78 both inclusive, and 81 to 90 both inclusive, aggregating \$17,900.00;

(b) Upshur County Road Bonds, Series "B" dated January 1, 1918, bearing 5% interest being numbered and maturing as follows:

Bonds Numbers 21 to 32, both inclusive, aggregating \$6000.00;

(c) Upshur County Road District No. Seven Bonds, dated January 1, 1916, bearing 5 1/2% interest being numbered and maturing as follows:

Bonds Numbers 21 to 25, both inclusive; 27 to 34, both inclusive, of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, aggregating \$13,000.00;

2. That said Refunding Bonds shall be numbered consecutively from One (1) to Seventy Two (72) inclusive shall be of the denomination of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars each, aggregating Thirty Six Thousand (\$36,000.00) Dollars.

3. They shall be dated the 1st day of May 1934, and shall become due and payable serially as follows:

The Commissioners' Court affirmatively adjudges that the maturities set forth above fixes as nearly as the Financial condition of the County will permit, an equal and uniform burden of taxation for the term of the indebtedness.

4. Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of 5% per annum, payable November 1, 1934, and semi-annually thereafter on the 1st day of May and the 1st day of November of each year, interest and principal of said bonds shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America, upon presentation and surrender of bond or proper coupon at the office of the State Treasurer of the State of Texas, in the City of Austin, State of Texas.

5. Each of said bonds shall be signed by the County Judge countersigned by the

County Clerk and registered by the County Treasurer and the seal of the Commissioners' Court shall be impressed upon each of them. The fac-simile signature of the County Judge and County Clerk may be lithographed or printed upon the coupons attached to said bonds and shall have the same effect as if they had been signed by them.

The County of Upshur, in the State of Texas, for value received hereby promise to pay to the bearer hereof, on the 1st day of May 19____ the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS in lawful money of the United States of America, with interest thereon from date hereof at the rate of Five (5%) per cent per annum, interest payable November 1, 1934, and thereafter semi-annually on the 1st day of May and the 1st day of November of each year, principal and interest payable upon presentation and surrender of bond or proper coupon at the office of the State Treasurer of the State of Texas, in the City of Austin, State of Texas, and the said County of Upshur is hereby held and firmly bound and its faith and credit and all real and personal property in said County are hereby pledged to the prompt payment of the principal of this bond and the interest thereon at maturity.

This bond is one of a series of Seventy Two (72) Bonds, numbered from One (1) to Seventy Two (72) both inclusive, of the denomination of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars each, aggregating Thirty Six Thousand (\$36,000.00) Dollars, and issued for the purpose of refunding cancelling and in lieu of Seventeen Thousand (\$17,000.00) Dollars of Upshur County Road District No. One Bonds, dated July 1, 1918, bearing 5% interest, Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars of Upshur County Road Bonds, Series "B" dated January 1, 1918, bearing 5% interest, Thirteen Thousand (\$13,000.00) Dollars of Upshur County Road District No. Seven Bonds, dated January 1, 1916, bearing 5 1/2% interest, the specific bonds refunded being described in the order of the Commissioners' Court authorizing this issuance of Refunding Bonds, the original bonds having been issued for the purpose of the construction, maintenance and operation of macadamized, gravelled or paved roads and turnpikes or in aid thereof, within and for said respective road districts Upshur County under and in strict conformity with the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, and pursuant to orders passed by the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, duly of record in the minutes of said Court; and Refunding Bonds having been authorized in strict conformity with the constitution and laws of the State of Texas and by an order passed by the Commissioners' Court of said County duly of record in the minutes of said Court.

The date of this Bond in conformity with the order above mentioned is the 1st day of May 1934.

AND IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED that the issuance of this Bond and the series of which it is a part, is duly authorized by law, and that all acts, conditions and things required to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this series of bonds, and of this bond, have been properly done and performed and have happened in regular and due time, form and manner as required by law; that due provision has been made for levying and collecting annually by taxation an amount sufficient to pay the interest on these bonds as it falls due and to provide a sinking fund for the final redemption of said bonds at maturity and that the issue of bonds of which this is one, together with all other indebtedness of said County, is within every debt and other limit prescribed by the Constitution and laws of said State.

The holder of this bond and the holder or holders of the series of which it is a part, in addition to all other rights, in and are subrogated to the rights secured to them under

the original issues of bonds refunded hereby.

9. A special fund to be designated "Upshur County Road Refunding Bonds, Series 1934-A Fund" is hereby created, and the proceeds from all taxes collected for or on account of this series of bonds shall be credited to said fund for the purpose of paying the interest and providing a sinking fund for the redemption of said bonds as they mature, and said fund shall be used for no other purpose; that to create said fund a tax of Eight (8¢) Cents on the One Hundred Dollars' valuation of taxable property in Upshur County is hereby levied for the current taxing year 1934, on all taxable property in said County; that for each of the years 1933 and succeeding years while any of the said bonds or interest thereon are outstanding and unpaid and at the time other County taxes are levied in each of said years, there shall be computed and ascertained what rate of tax based upon the latest approved tax rolls of said County will be necessary and sufficient to fully make, raise and produce in each of said years a proportionate part of the principal and the interest to be paid in that year, and for each of said years there is ordered to be levied and there is hereby levied, and

ordered to be assessed and collected, a tax at such rate as will be found necessary as aforesaid and all such taxes when collected shall be appropriated and applied to the purposes named.

10. The sum of \$900.00 is hereby appropriated out of available funds to pay the interest maturing on this issue of bonds November 1, 1934. The County Judge, County Clerk and County Treasurer are authorized and directed to transfer said sum to the interest and sinking created for this issue of bonds and said money shall be used for no other purposes than to pay the interest maturing on this series of bonds November 1, 1934.

11. All taxes in process of collection for the benefit of the issues of bonds refunded in this bond issue, and all moneys in the sinking funds of said respective bond issues are hereby appropriated to the interest and sinking fund of this bond issue. The County Judge, County Clerk and County Treasurer are directed to take such steps as are necessary to transfer said funds to the interest and sinking fund for this bond issue. Provided, however, that said transfer shall be made proportionately from time to time as and when said original bonds have been actually surrendered in exchange for said Refunding Bonds, in such manner that outstanding bonds not exchanged will always be protected by a proper interest and sinking fund heretofore provided for that purpose.

12. The County Judge is authorized to take and have charge of said bonds pending their investigation and approval by the Attorney General, after which time he is to deposit said bonds with the Comptroller of the State of Texas. Said refunding Bonds shall not be registered until and as a like amount of said original bonds have been surrendered to the Comptroller for cancellation. As and when said original bonds, either in one delivery or in installments, are surrendered to the Comptroller by H. C. Burt and Company, Dallas, Texas, or its order, he is authorized and directed to deliver the refunding bonds in like amounts to said H. C. Burt and Company, and upon presentation of an order signed by the County Judge of this County.

13. All orders and parts of orders in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
