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ORDER DECLARING RESULT OF BOND ELECTION.

IN COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT.

THE STATE OF TEXAS | IN THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF
 COUNTY OF UPSHUR | UPSHUR COUNTY:

On this, the 14 day of January A.D. 1935, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 12 day of January A.D. 1935, in (a) Glenwood Common School District No. 21, of this County, upon the question of issuing Eighteen thousand & no/100 (\$18,000.00) Dollars of Schoolhouse Bonds for said District, running 6 years, and bearing 5 per centum interest, and levying a tax upon all taxable property within said District sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal at maturity, and

IT APPEARING that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 55 votes, of which number there were cast: "FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF" - - 49 votes. "AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF" - - 6 votes.

AND IT APPEARING TO THE COURT from said returns that a majority of the legally qualified property taxpaying voters of said District, voting at said election, voted (b) for the issuance of said bonds, the Court does hereby declare the proposition for the issuance of said bonds to have been (c) adopted, (d) and that this Court is authorized to issue said bonds and to levy and to have assessed and collected said tax.

On this, the 14 day of January A.D. 1935, the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, convened in regular session, all the members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and, among other proceedings, passed the following order:

WHEREAS, at an election held for the purpose on the 12 day of January, A.D. 1935, a majority of the legally qualified resident property taxpaying voters of (a) Glenwood Common School District No. 21, of this County, having at said election, voted in favor of the issuance of the bonds hereinafter described and in favor of the tax hereinafter levied:

THEREFORE, BE IT REMEMBERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF Upshur COUNTY, TEXAS:

1.

That the bonds of said District to be called (a) "Glenwood Common School District No. 21, Schoolhouse Bonds" be issued on the faith and credit of said (a) Glenwood Common School District No. 21, of said County, as established by order of the (b) Commissioners Court as passed on the 12 day of October 1914, which order is of record in (c) Minutes of Commissioners Court, Vol. 4, p. 576. (d) for the purpose of (e) constructing and equipping

a brick bynasium and two class rooms.

II.

That said bonds shall be numbered consecutively from 1 to 24, inclusive, shall be of the denomination of Seven hundred fifty & no/100 (\$750.00) Dollars each, aggregating Eighteen thousand and no/100 (\$18,000.00) Dollars,

III.

That said bonds shall be dated (f) the 15 day of February A.D. 1935, shall become due and payable (g) \$1500.00 on Feb. 15, 1936, \$1500.00 on Feb. 15, 1937, and \$3750.00 on Feb. 15th of each year thereafter up to and including the year 1941 but (h) bonds numbered 4 to 24, both inclusive, may be redeemed at the pleasure of said District at any time after 2 years from their date.

IV.

That said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of (i) 5 per centum per annum, payable (j) annually on the 15 day of February, (k) and the -- day of ---of each year.

V.

That the principal of and the interest on said bonds shall be payable upon presentation and surrender of bonds or proper coupons, in lawful money of the United States of America, at the office of the Treasurer of the State of Texas, at Austin, Texas, or at office of County Treasurer of *****County, Texas, or at the --- Bank of (l)... (m)., at the option of the holder.

VI.

That the said bonds shall be signed by the County Judge, countersigned by the County Clerk and registered by the County Treasurer, and the seal of the Commissioners' Court shall be impressed upon each of them; the fac-simile signatures of the County Judge and County Clerk may be printed or lithographed on the coupons.

VII.

That the form of each of said bonds shall be substantially as follows:

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the County of Upchur, in the State of Texas, for and on behalf of (a) Glenwood Common School District No. 21, of said County, hereby promises to pay to bearer on the 15 day of February, A.D. 1936, the sum of Seven hundred fifty & no/100 (\$750.00) Dollars in lawful money of the United States of America, together with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of (i) 5 per centum per annum, interest payable (j)--- annually on the 15 day of February, (k) and the ** day of *** of each year, principal and interest payable upon presentation and surrender of bond or proper coupon at the office of the Treasurer of the State of Texas, at Austin, Texas, or at office of County Treasurer of***** County, Texas, or at the ****Bank of (l) **** (m) ****, at the option of the holder.

This bond is one of a series of 24 bonds, numbered consecutively from 1 to 24, inclusive, of the denomination of Seven hundred fifty (\$750.00) Dollars each, aggregating Eighteen thousand & no/100 (\$18,000.00) Dollars, issued by the Commissioners' Court of said County on the faith and credit of (a) Glendwood Common School District No. 21, of said County as established by order of the (n) Commissioners Court as passed on the 12 day of October 1914, which order is of record in (n) Minutes of Commissioners Court, Vol. 4, p. 576;

(n). ...for the purpose of (c) constructing and equipping a brick bymasium and two class rooms within said District, for said (a) Glenwood Common School District No. 21, under and by virtue of Sections 1 to 12, both inclusive, of Chapter 24 of the General Laws passed by the Thirty-seventh Legislature of the State of Texas at its Regular Session in 1921, and the Constitution and laws of said State, and in pursuance of an order passed by the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, on the 14 day of January, A.D. 1935, which order is of record in Book.. Pages. . ., of the Minutes of said Court.

(p) The said (a) Glenwood Common School District No. 21, has and hereby reserves the right to redeem this bond at any time after. . years from its date by paying principal and accrued interest, and, in case the same shall be called in for redemption before maturity, notice thereof in writing shall be given by the President of the District Trustees of said (a). Common School District No. .to the County Treasurer of said County at least thirty days before the date fixed for redemption, and should this bond not be presented for redemption it shall cease to bear interest from and after the date so fixed for redemption.

The date of this bond, in conformity with the order above mentioned, is the 15th day of February A.D. 1935.

AND IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED That all acts, conditions and things required to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have been properly done, happened and performed in regular and due form as required by law, and that the amount of this issue of bonds does not exceed any Constitutional or statutory limitation.

IX.

It is further ordered by the Court that while said bonds, or any of them, are outstanding and unpaid, there shall be annually levied, assessed and collected, in due time, form and manner, a tax upon all the taxable property in said Glenwood Common School District No. 21, sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and create a sinking fund sufficient

to pay each installment of the principal as the same becomes due, and to pay the interest on said bonds for the first year and to create a sinking fund with which to pay the principal to become due the first year, and there is hereby levied a tax of 20 cents on each One Hundred Dollars valuation of all taxable property in said district for the year 1935, and the same shall be assessed and collected and applied to the purpose named.
