

That we, First National Bank of Upshur County, Texas, as Principal, and U.S. Bonds, 3 1/8 maturity 46-49 amount \$20,000.00 and held in First National Bank of Dallas Texas for benefit of Commissioners court of Upshur County to protect this bond, as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto County Judge of Upshur County, Texas, and his successors in office, in the sum of Twenty thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars, for the payment of which we hereby bind ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally by these presents,

THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such that, whereas the above bounded First National Bank offered the highest bid of interest on daily balances (1 1/2 per cent) and was, on Feb. 11, 1935, chosen by the Commissioners' Court as depository of the funds of Upshur County, including the school funds, for the term of two years, beginning March 1, 1935.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said First National Bank shall safely keep and faithfully disburse the school funds according to law, and pay such warrants as may be drawn on said funds by competent authority, and shall account for them, together with interest thereon at the rate of 1 1/2 per cent per annum, calculated on daily balances, to the Commissioners' Court of said County and to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, as is required by law, then this obligation shall be void; but otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.

ORDER DECLARING RETURNS OF BOND ELECTION. HEPSIBAH SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2.

On this the 27th day of August, A.D. 1935, came onto be considered the returns of an election held on the 17th day of August, A.D. 1935, in Common County Line School District No. 2, of the counties of Camp, Wood and Upshur, upon the question of issuing \$500.00 of schoolhouse bonds for said district, running 16 years, and bearing, not to exceed 5 per cent interest, and levying a tax on all taxable property of said district sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal at maturity, and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 23 valid and legal votes, of which number there were cast:

And it appearing to the court from said returns that a majority of the legally qualified property taxpaying voters of said Hepsibah Common County Line School District, No. 2, in said District, voting at said election, voted in favor of issuing said bonds, the Court does hereby declare the proposition for the issuance of said bonds to have been adopted, and that this court is authorized to issue said bonds and to levy and have assessed and collected said tax.
