The boxes will be numbered in the County as follows: West Gilmer Precinct 3- will be Box 1 in Upshur County. West Gilmer Precinct 4 will be box 25 in Upshur County. East Gilmer Precinct One will be box 13 in Upshur County; East Gilmer Precinct Two will be box 26 in Upshur County.
