Motion made by Commissioner W. C. Henderson and seconded by Commissioner E. A. Cobb that the County and District Road Bond Indebtedness Board at Austin, Texas, be notified that it is the desire of the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, that the amount of \$34,733.53 credited to Upshur County be deposited by said Board with the County Treasurer of Upshur County who shall place said sum in the Lateral Road fund of Upshur County - Motion unanimously carried.

Having finished as Board of Equalization for time being the board was adjourned to meet again Sept. 9, 1940.
