PETITION FOR PUBLIC ROAD

To the Honorable Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas:

We, the undersigned citizens, free-holders, residing in the precincts through which the following described proposed road will run, pray that a public road of the 2nd class,

30 feet in width, be established in said County, having its points of beginning and ending as follows: FIELD NOTES. Beg at the South end of road from Shipp-Baugh to Indian Rock School; Thence South along and upon the property of G. Q. Baugh for about 300 yards; Thence Southwest upon the property of Kate M. Pieper for about 1/2 mile to the home of W. W. Cook. The undersigned property owners agree to furnish the above mentioned right of way free of cost to Upshur County.

On this the 10th day of February, A. D. 1941, came on to be heard the application of L. L. Motion made by H. S. Taff and seconded by E. A. Cobb that F & M Nat'l Bank be named depository for Upshur Co. funds and Upshur Co. School funds and that First Nat'l Bank be named to assist in handling of said funds, each bank placing securities to secure funds and making pledge contracts. The funds deposited in said banks shall draw no interest. Bond and pledge contracts by each bank shall be in the form and manner provided by law. No other banking institution other than above mentioned submitted bids. The First Nat'l Bank shall have on depòsit the Jury, R & B Bonds & Co. Bond. The F & M Bank shall have on deposit the General Permanent improvement, Salary Fund R & B #1, 2, 3 & 4.

Motion by H. S. Taff and seconded by G. L. Hart that the County buy some of the Co. road bonds if and when the Co. may secure said bonds at 2 or better basis. Motion passed Commissioner E. A. Cobb not voting.

Motion made, seconded and carried that the road contract of L. W. Pelphrey awarded oh Jan. 29th, 1941 is hereby ratified and bond covering same is hereby approved.

Motion carried to buy gravel from Gifford and Hill for Co. Office Bldg., to meet requirements.
