The Co. Clerk is further instructed to pay the \$10.00 omitted from check to Mrs. Hale for the month of July, warrants payable out of Jury Fund.

Motion made, seconded & carried to table all bids rec'd for the purchase of scraper until 10 o'clock Monday Morning Aug. 18th, 1941.

Motion made, seconded and carried that bid of Federal Laboratories of Pittsburg, Pa. be accepted as lowest and best bid for fire arms equipment for Sheriffs Dept. in the amount of \$513.45. Co Clerk authorized to issue warrant on Gen. Fund.
