Motion made by E. A. Cobb, seconded by H. S. Taff and voted unanimously that Co. Clerk, Co. Auditor and Co. Treasurer transfer \$551.23 from R & B 1 to the lateral road fund. The purpose of this order is to correct an error in expenditure of Commissioners Share of the above mentioned fund in Prec. #1.
