

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of May, 1942, the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, passed an order authorizing the issuance of \$6,400.00 Refunding Bonds of Common School District No. 50 of Upshur County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, in describing the original bond issue being refunded the interest rate of such bonds was inadvertently omitted; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court now deems it advisable and to the best interest of said School District that said order passed on May 23, 1942 be amended;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS:

I.

That the first paragraph of the preamble to the order authorizing the issuance of refunding bonds passed by the said Commissioners Court on the 23rd day of May, 1942, be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read hereafter as follows:

"WHEREAS, Common School District No. 50, of Upshur County, Texas, has outstanding its legally issued schoolhouse bonds, dated October 10, 1920, due October 10, 1940, bearing 5% interest per annum, numbered 1 to 20, inclusive, in denomination of \$300.00 each, aggregating \$6,000.00; and"

II.

That except as herein provided, said order passed by the Commissioners Court on May 23, 1942, shall remain in full force and effect.

The above order being read, it was moved and seconded that same do pass. Thereupon, the question being called for, the following members of the Court voted AYE: E. A. Cobb, H. S. Taff, J. M. Holloway, G. L. Hart; and the following votes NO: NONE.
