Commissioners Court met on a bove date in Regular Session with County Judge Sid Buie, and Commissioners, E. A. Cobb, H. S. Taff, L. G. McKinley and G. L. Hart Present.

Motion made seconded and carried that Bonds Nos. 55 and 56 of Road Dist. No. 7 dated Jan. 1, 1916, are optional Jan. 1, 1945, and that said Bonds are hereby called for payment Jan. 1, 1945.

Motion made, seconded and carried that Mr. G. W. DeBerry be granted an extension of time for Geophysical examination of Upshur County School lands to Jan. 1, 1945.

Motion made, seconded and carried that Mrs. Lucille Webb be paid \$135.00 per Mo. effective Dec. 1, 1944.

Motion made, seconded and carried that U. S. Gov. bonds be purchased from funds of Precinct #1, Upshur County, Texas, Road Dist. #1, Int. and Sinking funds Bonds in the sum of \$25,000.00 plus Int. from Dec. 1, 1944. Bonds to be purchased are the 1-1/4% 1947 maturity bonds.

Motion made, seconded and carried that U. S. Gov. 7/8 one Year maturity Bonds be purchased from funds of Road District #1, Int. and Sinking Funds in the sum of \$35,000.00 for said road district. Said amount plus int.

Motion made, seconded and carried that U. S. Gov. Bonds 7/8 one year maturity be purchased from funds of the Upshur County bond fund in the sum of \$40,000.00 for Bond Fund, said amt. plus int.

Motion made, seconded and carried that the returns of the election held in Brumley School Dist. #3, and Union Hill School Dist. #36, both Common School Districts, be canvassed. The hereunder listed report lists the returns as shown by said election reports are hereby adopted.
