 PETITION FOR ELECTION FOR ASSUMPTION OF BONDED INDEBTEDNESS

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY JUDGE

We, the undersigned resident qualified property taxpaying voters of (a) Union Hill Consolidated Common School District No. 36, in Upshur County, Texas, who own taxable property in said district and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, (b) do hereby respectfully pray that an election be ordered to be held in said district to determine whether or not (a) Union Hill Consolidated Common School District No. 36, shall assume, pay off and discharge all, or the agreed proportionate part, of the outstanding bonded indebtedness incurred prior to the formation of said District as it now exists, said indebtedness consisting of schoolhouse bonds described as follows: Bonds dated Amount issued Amount due
