ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS' COURT

UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS.

Special Session, Aug. 9th, A.D. 1945, at the Courthouse of Upshur County in the City of Gilmer, Texas, at 10 o'clock A.M., with the following members present, to-wit:

When and where the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Upon motion made by Commissioner M. O. Holmes, duly seconded by Commissioner E. A. Cobb, the following action was taken:

BE IT ORDERED by the Commissioners' COURT of Upshur County, that W. A. Lunsford, County Judge of Upshur County be and he is hereby authorized to enter into and execute for and on behalf of Upshur County, an agreement with the State of Texas herein Upshur County will agree to waive and relinquish any and all rights Upshur County and/or road district has or may have for participation by the State in the payment of any County and/or road district bonds, warrants, or other evidences of indebtedness incurred by Upshur COUNTY and/or road district in the construction, reconstruction, or maintenance Intersection with U.S. Hwy. 271 in Bettie, Northwesterly to of the county road from Thomas (Commonly known as Simpsonville) upon condition the Highway Commission of the State of Texas, will designate such road as a farm-to-market road as contemplated by S. B. No. 348/ Acts of the Forty-Eighth Legislature, 1943, and construct, reconstruct, and/or maintain the same at the sole cost and expense of the State as a part of the designated highway system of Texas; that the designation of the road by the Highway Commission shall never form the basis of a claim for participation by the State in the payment of any County and/or road district bonds, warrants, or other evidences of indebtedness against said road; to agree to remove or abate any and all encroachments or encumbrances on said road or right-of-way at the sole expense of the County before its designation by the Highway Commission, and to further agree to obtain at its expense any new or additional right-of-way on location approved by the State Highway Engineer at any time the same should be considered necessary or desirable to the proper maintenance, construction, or reconstruction of said road as a part of the State System; to agree to indemnify and save harmless the State from all claims, demands, actions or causes of actions arising from or growing out of or damage to property resulting in any manner from the
