 APPLICATION OF G. L. FLORENCE FOR USE OF COUNTY MACHINERY UNDER ARTICLE 2372-C.
 TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS:

Now comes G. L. Florence, independent executor under the will and of the estate of Mrs. M. E. Florence, deceased, and hereby makes application to your Honorable Body for the use of county machinery and road equipment to dig some ditches as provided for in Art. 2372-C R. C. S. 1925, and in this connection would respectfully show to the court the following:

1. That as such executor he has in his possession and under his control a certain 175 acre tract of land, more or less, located and situated in Upshur County, Texas, about 9-1/2 miles Southeast of the town of Gilmer, in the Wm. King HR survey, which belongs to your applicant and the other children and heirs of the said Mrs. M.E. Florence, deceased.

2. That there is a creek, commonly known as Bog Creek, running through said farm in an easterly and westerly direction; that said creek has been dammed up by trees, tree tops, limbs, logs, brush and sand to where the water is not running in its natural creek bed and course, and as a result thereof the water of said creek is now flowing out upon and across said lands adjacent to said creek, which is causing great damage, waste and lack of productiveness of and to said lands.

3. That in order to correct the situation herein complained of it will be necessary to dig two ditches, one approximately 250 yards in length and the other approximately 300 yards in length to a depth of approximately two feet and a width of approximately three feet; that your applicant has been unable to employ private labor to dig said ditches although he has contacted many people with reference to digging same; that he here makes application to your Honorable Body that said ditches be dug under the supervision of E.A. Cobb, County Commissioner of said precinct with County machinery under the provisions of Art. 2372-C.

4. That upon a completion of said ditches your affiant is ready, able and willing to pay to the county for the benefit of the road and bridge fund a reasonable sum to be agreed upon by the parties or fixed by the Commissioner's Court for such services.

Commissioners Court met in special session with County Judge, W.A. Lunsford, and Commissioners, E.A. Cobb, H. S. Taff, L. G. McKinley and M. O. Holmes Present;

Bids were received and opened for the Construction of a portion of the Gilmer and Glenwood road in Precinct One. There were two bids received from L. W. Polphey and Southern Contracting Company, both of which are on file in the County Clerks office, after proper deliberation and consideration. It was ascertained that the bid of the Southern Contracting Company was the lowest and best bid.

Therefore, a motion was duly made by Commissioner Cobb and seconded by Commissioner Taff, and unamously carried that the bid of Southern Contracting Company be accepted, as shown in the proposal to the Commissioners court, on file with the County Clerk.

It was agreed in open court between the contracting parties that the Commissioners court at the time it became necessary for the Contractors to apply the Asphalt surface treatment, would then determine which type of treatment it desires to be. Governed by the four types of treatment as shown in bid.
