Commissioners Court met in special session with all members present.

Motion made, seconded and carried that: Effective July 1st, 1947, Warrants issue for Upshur County Health Unit as follows, to wit:

County Clerk authorized to issue warrants on General Fund for same.

Motion made by commissioner Gatlin and seconded by Commissioner Shaw that Upshur County make a final payment to the Board of County and District Road Bond Indebtedness, Austin, Texas, in the amount of \$54,903.71 out of the County Bond Fund, same being Upshur County's portion of all principal and interest due and that will be due on all Upshur County Bonds outstanding at this time, and that in further payment of Upshur County's portion of same that the County Treasurer assign and deliver \$28,000.00 Upshur County Bonds owned by the County Bond Fund. It is understood the State of Texas will reimburse Upshur County for six (6) of these bonds, this being a part of this agreement. Motion declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gatlin and seconded by Commissioner Shaw that the County Treasurer, James Berry, be authorized and is instructed to ask for payment through the Farmers & Merchants National Bank of Gilmer, Texas, for \$25,000.00 United States Treasury notes C due 1947, Bond Nos. 770 in the Amount of \$5,000.00 and 1705 in the amount of \$10,000.00, and 1706 in the amount of \$10,000.00. Also the following described United States Savings Bonds, Series F issued February 1st, 1943, and due Twelve (12) years from such date: No. X114554F-\$10,000.00, No. X114552F-\$10,000.00, No. X114553F-\$10,000.00, No. V108344F-\$5,000.00 and the County Treasurer is authorized and instructed to sign each of said bonds as County Treasurer with the request that Upshur County receive payment for same. Motion declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Shaw and seconded by Commissioner Gatlin that the County Treasurer, James Berry, be authorized and is instructed to indorse the checks received from the Federal Reserve Bank in Dallas, Texas, in payment of the above described Series F Bonds, namely, No. X114554F-\$10,000.00, No. X114552F-\$10,000.00, No. X114553F-\$10,000.00 and No. V108344F-\$5,000.00 to the Farmers & Merchants National Bank, of Gilmer, Texas. It is understood that the Farmers & Merchants National Bank of Gilmer, Texas, will take care of the check that has heretofore been issued on the County Bond Fund to the State of Texas. Motion declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gatlin and seconded by Commissioner Shaw that the surplus remaining in the County Bond Fund be divided equally among the four precincts, excepting such portion as may be set aside by the Court for the purchase of right of way. Motion declared carried.
