

the said party of the second part hereby agrees to make all necessary surveys, plans, specifications and estimates, and to supervise the construction of said work to completion.

The party of the second part agrees to begin work on the preparation of plans, specifications, and proposals for the above work within five days after the date of this contract, and after the construction contract has been awarded, to furnish adequate supervision of construction work until its final completion by the contractor and its acceptance by the party of the first part. Which final acceptance will terminate this contract.

The party of the second part further agrees to do all of the above mentioned engineering work at his own proper cost and expense, and to furnish all copies of plans and specifications necessary for the awarding of the construction contract and the execution of the work.

And, the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the full and true performance of the above mentioned engineering work by the party of the second part, hereby agrees and binds itself to pay to the said party of the second part five per cent (5%) of the construction cost of said work in the following manner to-wit: two and one-half per cent (2½%) of the contract price to be due and payable upon the award of the construction contract, and the remaining two and one-half per cent (2½%) to be due and payable upon the final completion and acceptance of the work.
