On this the 11 day of August, 1952, the County Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, convened in regular session at the regular meeting place of said court in the courthouse at Gilmer, Texas, all members of the court being present; and, among other proceedings had by said court were the following:

Motion was made and seconded and unanimously carried, and it is so ordered, that the common boundary line between Justice Precinct No. 8 of Upshur County, Texas, and Justice Precinct No. 2 of said county, be changed from its present location and description to be read as follows:

Beginning on the Upshur-Harrison County Line at the North Right of Way line of the old Gilmer-Jefferson Public Road; THENCE in a Southwesterly direction along the North Right of Way Line of said old Gilmer-Jefferson Public Road to its intersection with the West Right of Way Line of State Highway No. 26; THENCE in a Northerly direction along the West Right of Way Line of State Highway No. 26 to its intersection with the North Line of the James M. Dunn HR Survey; THENCE West with the North Line of James M. Dunn HR Survey to the center-line
