The Chairman placed before the Board the following order relating to the Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District, of Camp, Upshur and Wood Counties, Texas, ratifying and confirming an order of the County Board of School Trustees of Camp County, Texas, and defining the boundaries of said District.

WHEREAS, heretofore, to wit: on the 7th day of July, 1952, the County Board of School Trustees of Camp County, Texas, passed and adopted the following order, a copy of which is on record in this Board's Minutes and in the "Record of School Districts" of Upshur County, Texas:

ON THIS the 7th day of July, 1952, the County Board of School Trustees of Camp County, Texas, met at the regular meeting place of said Board in regular session with the following members present and in attendance:

and the following members absent: None, constituting a quorum, at which meeting, the following proceedings, among others, were had:

There came on to be considered the matter of consolidating Newsome Common School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, with an adjoining and contiguous district; and

IT APPEARING to the County Board of School Trustees of Camp County, Texas, that Newsome Common School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, is dormant as same is fully defined by Senate Bill No. 116, passed by the 51st Legislature in 1949, as fully set out in Article VIII of said Bill; and

IT IS NOW FOUND by the County Board of School Trustees that Newsome Common School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, is a dormant district, having failed for two successive years subsequent to 1946-1947 school year, to operate a school in the district for the year having the greater number of enumerated scholastics within said district; and

IT IS FURTHER FOUND that Newsome Common School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, lies wholly within Camp County, Texas; and

IT APPEARING to this Board that under and by virtue of the provisions of Senate Bill 116, particularly Article VIII thereof, it becomes the duty and obligation of this Board to consolidate the dormant school district, to wit: Newsome Common School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, with an adjoining or contiguous district; and

IT IS FURTHER here set out that the matter of consolidating the said Newsome Common School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, with the Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District, of Camp, Upshur and Wood Counties, Texas, has been fully discussed with a majority of the resident, taxpaying voters of said District by this Board, and the matter has been discussed by this Board with the trustees of said District and with the trustees of Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District; and

IT APPEARING to said County Board that the Newsome Common School District Number 803

is contiguous to and adjoins Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District; and

IT IS FURTHER FOUND that the boundary lines of said Newsome Common School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, are as follows:

BEGINNING at the Southwest corner of the former Leesburg Independent School District, being the Southwest corner of a 67 acre tract now owned by J. B. Florence, formerly owned by Richard G. Batt, 1070 varas East from the West boundary line of the Lucinda Williams Survey, near the center of said West line; THENCE West 1070 varas to the West boundary line of said Lucinda Williams Survey, the Southwest corner of the former Lizzie Jones land, on the East boundary line of the Floyd Jones land; THENCE South 1228 varas, with said Lucinda Williams Survey West line to the Northeast corner of the Willage Wilkinson 60 acres in the Mary Archa Survey, a stake in the Scroggins Mill Road; THENCE West with said Scroggins Mill Road 1618 varas to the Southwest corner of the Floyd Jones 90 acre tract; THENCE North 75 varas, a stake at Dan Allen's Southeast corner, on Floyd Jones West boundary line; THENCE West, still with said Scroggins Mill Road, 2617 varas, an iron stake at E. C. Bailey's Northwest corner and the Southwest corner of the J. H. Acker 29 acre tract, being the County Line between Camp and Wood Counties; THENCE North with said County Line 7621 varas, a stake in the old B. E. Hanson North boundary line on the Louis Rose Survey, the Northwest corner of the former Newsome School District, at 8971 varas with said County Line to Brushy Creek, being the Southeast County Line between Camp and Franklin Counties; THENCE Northeasterly, with Brushy Creek and said County Line, to the intersection of Brusy Creek with Cypress Creek, being the County Line between Titus and Camp Counties; THENCE Easterly, with said Cypress creek and Camp and Titus County Line, to the point of intersection of Camp Branch with Big Cypress, being the Northwest corner of the Leesburg Independent School District; THENCE up Camp Branch, South $29\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ West 280 varas; South 10° West 560 varas; South 22° West 830 varas; South 25° East 810 varas; South 80° East 136 varas; South $76\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 250 varas; South $50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 117 varas; South 49° East 330 varas; South $36\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 160 varas; South 55° East 60 varas; South $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 150 varas; South 02° East 370 varas; South 48° East 90 varas; South 34° East 120 varas; South 44° East 190 varas; South 27° East 124 varas, a corner in Camp Branch on the North line of the S. D. Thomas Survey, said point being 1622 varas East of the Northwest corner of said Survey; THENCE West 772 varas, a stake on the North boundary line of said S. D. Thomas Survey, at the Northeast corner of the I. C. Boles 50 acre tract; THENCE South 573 varas, a stake at the Northeast corner of the Black Estate; THENCE West 422 varas, the Northwest corner of said Black Estate; THENCE South 976 varas, the Southwest corner of said Black Estate; THENCE West 168.4 varas with the North boundary line of the Frank Reynolds tract; THENCE with Reynolds' West boundary line, South 827.1 varas; South 28° East 144.6 varas; South 54.8 varas, the southwest corner of said Frank Reynolds tract and the Southeast corner of the R. T. Martin land; THENCE East 210 varas, the Northeast corner of the Henry Julian tract; THENCE South $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 390 varas, the Southeast corner of said Julian Tract; THENCE West 445 varas, the Southwest corner of said Julian tract, formerly J. C. Martin, on the West boundary line of the S. D. Thomas Survey, and the East boundary line of the Leesburg Independent School District; THENCE, with the West line of said Leesburg Independent School District, South 2587.5 varas, to the Southwest corner of the S. D. Thomas Survey, at 4401 varas, to the place of beginning.

IT IS FURTHER FOUND by this Board that the above description of the boundaries of the said Newsome Common School District; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING to this Board that it is to the best interests of the schools involved and to the patrons and residents of the territory affected that said Newsome Common

School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, be consolidated with the Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District, of Camp, Upshur and Wood Counties, Texas;

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the County Board of School Trustees of Camp County, Texas, that Newsome Common School District Number 803, of Camp County, Texas, a dormant district, be and it is hereby annexed to and consolidated with and becomes a part of the Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District, of Camp, Upshur and Wood Counties, Texas, all in accordance with the provisions of Senate Bill 116, of the 51st Legislature of the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD that the Board of Trustees with which said dormant school district is consolidated shall continue to serve and be the Board of Trustees for the new district, and the proper authorities hereafter shall cause an election to be held on the assumption of debt and the levy of a tax therefor, and the levying of a local maintenance tax as provided under Senate Bill 116, the election to be held as provided by law; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING to the County Board of School Trustees that it becomes the duty of this Board, after consolidation of said districts, to redefine the boundary lines of said Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND DETERMINED by the County Board of School Trustees of Camp County, Texas, that the boundary lines of Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District, after consolidation with Newsome Common School District Number 803, be and the same is hereby defined as follows:

FIELD NOTES of Pittsburg County-Line Consolidated Independent School District, amended, to include Newsome District, situated in the Counties of Camp, Upshur and Wood, described as follows:

BEGINNING on the South bank of Big Cypress Creek in the North boundary line of Camp County, at the Northeast corner of the N. W. Carter Headright Survey, being the Northeast corner of the present Sheppard Common School District and the Northwest corner of the former Midway Common School District; THENCE Easterly and Southeasterly with Cypress Creek and the North and Northeast line of Camp County, crossing the M. Hitchens, John Brower, R. B. Hutchins, two surveys of G. C. Hopkins, Moses Barnes, J. W. Bailey surveys, and with the East line of the G. C. Hopkins Survey, Abstract No. 142, and the East line of the H. L. Hess Survey, crossing the J. M. Monroe Survey, Moses Barnes Survey, Abstract No. 6, John Hobbs Survey and D. A. Russell Survey to the point where Cypress Creek hits the East line of the W. M. Smithson Survey, being the Southeast corner of the old Common School District No. 4, known as Garfield; THENCE North 20° West with the East line of said Smithson Survey, 250 varas to the Northeast corner of said survey; THENCE South 70° West with the North line of said Smithson Survey and the South line of the D. A. Russell and John Hobbs Surveys, 1234 varas, the Northwest corner of the said Survey and the Northwest corner of the Common School District No. 6, known as Center Point, and the Northeast corner of Common School District No. 5, known as Ebernezer;

THENCE South 70° West with the North boundary line of the G. J. Williams Survey, the same being the North boundary line of the W. J. Barnwell and Mrs. R. E. Barnwell land, at 2819 varas, the Northwest corner of the said G. J. Williams Survey, on the East line of the J. B. Reeves Survey, at 4350 varas a stake on the East bank of Stubble Field Creek, known as Dry Creek, elm bears South 28° East 6 varas; THENCE up said Dry Creek with its meanderings, South 50° West 130 varas; South $78\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 200 varas; South 35° West 540 varas; South 67° West 180 varas; South $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 385 varas, to the center of the bridge across Dry Creek, at the east end of the dump on the road from Pittsburg to Jackson's Store; THENCE with said road toward Pittsburg, South $78\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 310 varas, to a stake at Mrs. Gibson's mail box; North 76° West

1250 varas, a point near the old Club Lake, being the Northwest corner of the John Lineberger land; THENCE South $34\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 280 varas and then South $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 245 varas along the West boundary line of the John Lineberger tract to ell corner; THENCE in a direction South 70° West 421 varas to another Northwest corner of John Lineberger's land, which is a point on the South boundary line of Gilbert Wilson's land, formerly owned by W. C. Hargrove; THENCE South 09° West 966 varas to the Northwest corner of Vernon Lockett's land and the Southwest corner of the John Lineberger land; THENCE continuing in South 09° West direction, 390 varas along West line of Vernon Lockett land to a West "V" corner of same, on the Davis Road; THENCE North 69° West 107 varas along said road to a point where the South boundary line of F. McNary et al land leaves said road; THENCE along the South boundary line of the McNary Land, South 70° West 170 varas and then South $43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 120 varas, to the Southeast corner of Loyd Richardson's farm; THENCE along the South boundary line of said Richardson farm South 70° West 687.6 varas to the Southwest corner of said Richardson farm, same being the Southeast corner of the L. E. Reynolds farm, at 1201.6 varas, to Lafayette and Pittsburg Road, being a point which bears South $38\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East approximately 475 varas from Locust tree in the Northeast corner of Warrick's yard; THENCE with said Lafayette and Pittsburg road South $38\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East approximately 125 varas; South 23° East 1460 varas; South 44° East 1030 varas; South 37° East 130 varas to a stake in said road, South of Bolton's Graveyard; THENCE North 70° East 950 varas to a stake in field; THENCE South 20° East 1750 varas to a stake on the South boundary line of Jim Vick place; THENCE South 70° West 950 varas to a rock in Lafayette Road at Birdsong's corner and the N. W. corner of Sam Beck's land and the Southwest corner of old Jim Vick's place; THENCE with said Lafayette and Pittsburg Road, South 40° East 234 varas; South 57° East 375 varas, to a stake in center of said road where the lane South of Elmo Beck's land crosses said road; THENCE South 61° East 615 varas with Pittsburg and Lafayette road, to the South boundary line of J. A. Guest's 96.1 acre tract; THENCE North 70° East 1052 varas with Bob McGee's North boundary line to his Northeast corner; THENCE North 20° West 120 varas to the Northwest corner of Louis Marr's land, on the West boundary line of the Jessie Kitchen's Survey; THENCE North 70° East 1350 varas to stake in road running East along Bob McGee's South boundary line and on North line of Louis Marr's land, Northeast corner of same; THENCE South 20° East 1075 varas, with Marr's East boundary line to a stake on North bank of Prairie Creek; THENCE down Prairie Creek with its meanderings crossing the South boundary line of said Kitchen's Survey to a point where said creek intersects the East boundary line of the Mary Hays Survey, which is also the point of intersection of said creek with Pittsburg-Ebenezer Road; THENCE South 20° East along East boundary line of the Mary Hays Survey 550 varas to the ell corner of Bessie Willis' land; THENCE South 70° West 594 varas to the Northwest corner of L. E. Reynolds' land; THENCE South 20° East 1180 varas, the Southwest corner of said Reynolds tract; THENCE North 70° East 600 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas to the Southeast corner of said Reynolds' land, same being a point on Eastboundary line of the Mary Hays Survey and also the Northwest corner of the Church land; THENCE South 20° East 531 varas along West boundary line of church land, which is also the East boundary line of Mary Hays Survey, to the Northwest corner of Tom Laney's land, the Southwest corner of Joe Pankhurst's 146 acre tract, THENCE North 70° East 710 varas along the North line of Tom Laney's land to Northeast corner of same; THENCE South 20° East 1038.9 varas to the Southeast corner of Tom Laney's land, the North boundary line of Nancy Davis Survey; THENCE South 70° West 175 varas along North line of Nancy Davis Survey to the Northwest corner of Ollie Dooley land, a branch intersects North boundary line of Nancy Davis Survey; THENCE South $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 340 varas along West line of B. Cash's land and Ollie Dooley's land; THENCE South $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 140 varas to the North corner of said B. Cash land; THENCE South 50° West 175 varas to a West corner of said

B. Cash land; THENCE South 20° East 90 varas to the South corner of said B. Cash's land, which is also the Southwest corner of P. S. Cesh's land; THENCE in an Easterly direction 700 varas along the South boundary line of said P. S. Cash land to southeast corner of P. S. Cash's land; THENCE North 20° West 937.6 varas along West boundary line of W. E. Duncan's land to Northwest corner of said Duncan land located in Nancy Davis Survey, a branch; THENCE continuing down said branch to a point where said branch intersects with West boundary line of H. M. Robinson Survey, same being a point 145 varas South 20° East from e'l corner of said survey; THENCE with the meanderings of said branch in a direction about North 70° East with the South boundary line of A. J. Roberts' land and the original R. S. Messey land, which is now owned by Rockwell and Dooley, approximately 1300 varas, to the Southeast corner of A. J. Roberts' land; THENCE North 20° West 950 varas to A. J. Robert's Northeast corner; THENCE South 70° West 765 varas to Southwest corner of Ella Coffman's land; THENCE North 20° West at 318.5 varas, C. H. Bunt's Southwest corner, at 976 varas, said Bunt's N. W. corner, and at 1275 varas an iron stake at Bergen Johnson's Southeast corner; THENCE South 70° West 939 varas to a stake West of Wilk's Mountain, at said Johnson's Southwest corner, post oak stump bears South 43° East 6 varas; THENCE North $11\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 340 varas, to a large red oak tree; THENCE North $57\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 150 varas, to a stake; THENCE North 75.6 varas to a stake, which is Johnson's Northwest corner and is on Pankhurst's South boundary line; THENCE North 70° East 836.4 varas, H. R. Morris and Long line; North 78° East 270 varas; North 63° East 140 varas; South 25° East 260 varas; South 35° East (at 140 varas Big Cypress) 256 varas; South 12° West 200 varas, down Cypress, South 50° East (at 37 varas, Morris & Patrick line) 107 varas to mouth of Richland Creek; THENCE down said Big Cypress Creek with its meanderings North 67° East 100 varas; South 4° East 460 varas; South 25° East 555 varas; South 27° East 410 varas; South 30° East 255 varas; South 62° East 795 varas; to the South boundary line of Patrick Henry Survey, at 1485 varas, the East boundary line of C. Morris Survey, at 2710 varas; THENCE still with Cypress Creek, South 75° East 800 varas, North 30° East 530 varas; South 48° East 1580 varas; South 8° East 190 varas to the Southeast corner of Camp County and the Northeast corner of Upshur County; THENCE still down said Big Cypress Creek with its meanderings in Upshur County, the general course of which is South 30° East 1860 varas to the Northeast corner of a survey in the name of John Lowery and the Northern Southeast corner of a survey in the name of Ahira Butler; THENCE South 60° West with the line between said Lowery Survey and the Ahira Butler Survey 5816 varas, to the Northwest corner of the said John Lowery, same being the Southeast corner of a 200 acre tract on said Butler Survey, now owned by E. J. Smith, known as the J. A. Moody tract; THENCE North 67° West

1300 varas to the Southwest corner of said tract; THENCE North $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 165 varas to the Southeast corner of a tract of land on said Butler Survey, known as the J. A. L. Davis 200 acre tract; THENCE West with the South line of said tract 1190 varas to the Southwest corner of same in the West line of A. Butler Survey; THENCE South 30° East with said line 425 varas to the Southeast corner of the E. Wilkerson Survey, same being the Northeast corner of old Newsome District No. 39; THENCE South 70 deg West 1590 varas to the Northwest corner of S. C. Minor Survey; THENCE South 20 deg West 120 varas to a corner of Mary J. Webb Survey; THENCE South 70 deg West 268 varas to a point where the East line of old Cox School District No. 6 (now Union Ridge District) crosses the South line of a survey in the name of C. B. Fry; THENCE North with the East line of said Cox (Union Ridge) District, passing through the Mary J. Webb Survey, the Nancy Permenter Survey, Jonathan Martin and Wiley Helms Surveys, 6217 varas to the Northeast corner of old Cox District No. 6 (now Union Ridge), which is a point in County Line between Camp and Upshur Counties, same being the Northeast corner of the Wiley Helms' Survey; THENCE West with said County Line about 925 varas to a stake on said County Line on a line between W. A. Smith and J. L. Helms', which is also the Southeast corner of original Holly Springs District No. 8; THENCE West 3245 varas, with Upshur and Camp Counties line to the center of Richland Creek near the Dooley Bridge, which is a point on the South boundary line of old Lafayette District; THENCE up said Richland Creek South 24 deg. West 1600 varas; South $8\frac{1}{2}$ deg East 700 varas; South 17 deg West 540 varas; South 58 deg West 100 varas; to Gregory Bridge, at 400 varas; South $83\frac{1}{2}$ deg West 600 varas; South $69\frac{1}{2}$ deg West 200 varas, to Monte Bridge on said North branch of Richland Creek; North 56 deg. West 520 varas; North 61 deg West 900 varas; North 80 deg.
