PRECINCT NO. 8 BETWEEN VOTING PRECINCTS NOS.
18 AND 19

COUNTY OF UPSHUR |

On this the 11 day of August, 1952, the County Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, convened in regular session at the regular meeting place of said court in the courthouse at Gilmer, Texas, all members of the court being present; and, among other proceedings had by said court were the following:

Motion was made and seconded and unanimously carried, and it is so ordered, that the common boundary line between Justice Precinct No. 8 of Upshur County, Texas, and Justice Precinct No. 2 of said county, be changed from its present location and description to be read as follows:

Beginning on the Upshur-Harrison County Line at the North Right of Way line of the old Gilmer-Jefferson Public Road; THENCE in a Southwesterly direction along the North Right of Way Line of said old Gilmer-Jefferson Public Road to its intersection with the West Right of Way Line of State Highway No. 26; THENCE in a Northerly direction along the West Right of Way Line of State Highway No. 26 to its intersection with the North Line of the James M. Dunn SR Survey; THENCE West with the North Line of James M. Dunn SR Survey to the center-line

of the Old Diana-Boxwood Public Road; THENCE in a Northerly direction along the center-line of the Old Diana-Boxwood Public Road to a point even with the South Lines of the Richard Diviney and John T. Smith, No. 443, H R Surveys; THENCE West with the South Lines of said Richard Diviney and John T. Smith HR Surveys to the Southwest corner of the J. H. Hudspeth 120 acre tract of land on said John T. Smith H R Survey; THENCE North with the West line of said 120 acre tract to the Northwest corner of same, the same point being the Northeast corner of a 100 acre tract of land on said John T. Smith H R Survey belonging to J.J. Jeffrey; THENCE West with the North Line of said 100 acre Jeffrey tract of land to the Northwest corner of same; THENCE North to the North Line of the said John T. Smith H R Survey; THENCE West along the North Line of said John T. Smith H R Survey and the North Line of the Ruben Wyatt HR Survey, crossing the John Parker HR Survey to the Southeast corner of the J. Loyd HR Survey and continuing West to the present West Line of Justice Precinct No. 8.

Motion was made and seconded and unanimously carried, and it is so ordered, that Voting Precinct No. 8, known as the Stamps Box, be abolished and that that portion of said Voting Precinct No. 8 transferred and by this order made a part of Justice Precinct No. 2, be made a part of Voting Precinct No. 19, known as the Ore City Box, and that that portion of said Voting Precinct No. 8, by this order remaining a part of Justice Precinct No. 8, be made a part of Voting Precinct No. 18, known as the New Diana Box.
