On this 31 day of March 1953 the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, convened in Special session at the regular meeting place thereof in the courthouse at Gilmer, Texas, the following members, to-wit:

The County Judge submitted to the Court the following order:

ORDER

CREATING A JOINT AIR PORT ZONING BOARD TO BE KNOWN AS THE GLADEWATER JOINT AIRPORT ZONING BOARD AND INVESTING SUCH JOINT BOARD WITH THE POWERS SUCH BOARDS ARE AUTHORIZED TO EXERCISE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 391 OF THE ACTS OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE 50TH LEGISLATURE, 1947.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF THE COUNTY OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. Subject to like provision being made by the City Council of the City of Gladewater, Texas, by proper ordinance, duly promulgated and entered on its minutes, and as authorized by the provisions of Chapter 391 of the Acts of the Regular Session of the 50th Legislature, 1947, there is hereby created a joint airport zoning board, to be known as the Gladewater Joint Airport Zoning Board, which shall have the powers and exercise the duties set forth in Sections 2 and 3 of Chapter 391 of the Acts of the Regular Session of the 50th Legislature, 1947.

Section 2. The Gladewater Joint Airport Zoning Board shall be composed of seven (7) members, two to be appointed by the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, two to be appointed by the Commissioners' Court of Gregg County, Texas, and two members to be appointed by the City Council of the City of Gladewater, Texas. The seventh member shall be elected by a majority of the members so appointed and said seventh member shall serve as Chairman of the said Gladewater Joint Airport Zoning Board.

Section 3. H. H. (Bud) Shipp and G. O. Weiser are hereby appointed as the County's members on said Gladewater Joint Airport Zoning Board.

The above order having been read in full, the motion of Commissioner J. E. Venn for its passage was duly seconded by Commissioner Jim Shockey.

Thereupon the question being called for, the County Judge put the motion to a vote of the members of the Commissioners' Court and the motion carried by the following vote:
