the Cause, upon writ of error, to revise or reverse your judgment  
between

J. O. Duncan, County Attorney vs. Clayton Willis et al.

No. 6104 in the Supreme Court of Texas.

No. 11,467 in the District Court of Upshur County, Texas,  
was determined; and therein our said Supreme Court entered its  
judgment or order in these words:

"This cause came on to be heard on writ of error to the  
Court of Civil Appeals for the Sixth Supreme Judicial District,  
and the original transcript and the transcript showing the  
proceedings had in the Court of Civil Appeals having been duly  
considered, because it is the opinion of the Court that there was  
no error in the judgment of the Court of Civil Appeals, as follows:

" This cause came on to be heard on the transcript of the  
record, and the same being inspected, the Court is of the opinion  
that there was error in the judgment of the Court below in ren-  
dering judgment for the Appellee, J. O. Duncan, County Attorney  
of Upshur County, Texas, Contestee in the Trial Court, on November  
9, 1955, instead of rendering judgment for the Appellants, Clayton  
Willis, W. E. Witcher, D. P. Cavitt, Aubrey Davis, and L. M. Bain,  
the Contestants in the Trial Court, and that the same should be  
reversed and judgment now here rendered for said Appellants, as  
such judgment is hereinafter set forth.

" IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE  
COURT that the judgment in this cause as rendered by the Trial  
Court on November 9, 1955, and entered by the Trial Court on  
November 19, 1955, be and the same is reversed and judgment is  
now here rendered for the Appellants herein, Clayton Willis,  
W. E. Witcher, D. P. Cavitt, Aubrey Davis, and L. M. Bain, that  
the election for Consolidation of the Glenwood Common School  
District No. 21 of Upshur County, Texas, and the East Mountain  
Common School District No. 31 of Upshur County, Texas, held in  
the said Glenwood Common School District No. 21 of Upshur County,  
Texas, on April 30, 1955, carried for Consolidation of said  
Districts by a majority of the legal ballots and votes cast in  
said election, that is, 94 votes for Consolidation and 91 votes  
against Consolidation.

" IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT  
that a majority of the legal votes cast in both the said Glenwood  
Common School District No. 21 of Upshur County, Texas and the

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East Mountain Common School District No. 31, of Upshur County, Texas, voting separately in said Districts in the Election held in each of said Districts on the 30th day of April, 1955, were cast and voted for the Consolidation of said Districts for school purposes, and that said Glenwood Common School District No. 21 of Upshur County, Texas and the said East Mountain Common School District No. 31 of Upshur County, Texas be and they are hereby consolidated for school purposes in accordance with the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas.

" IT IS ALSO FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COURT that the officers of this Court and the Court below recover of the appellants, Clayton Willis, W. E. Witcher, D. P. Cavitt, Aubrey Davis, and L. M. Bain and of L. D. Webb and T. A. Webb, Sureties upon the said Appellants' Appeal Bond, all costs incurred by said Appellants on this appeal, for all of which execution may issue;

" IT IS ALSO ORDERED BY THE COURT that this decision be certified to the Court below for observance."

it is therefore adjudged, ordered and decreed that said judgment be, and is hereby, affirmed; that the costs in the Court of Civil Appeals remain as taxed in the judgment of that Court; that petitioner, J. O. Duncan, County Attorney of Upshur County, Texas, pay all costs incurred and expended in this Court, and that this decision be certified to the District Court of Upshur County, Texas, for observance."

WHEREFORE WE COMMAND YOU to observe the order of our said Supreme Court in this behalf, and in all things to have it duly recognized, obeyed and executed.


