JANUARY 7, 1959

Special called meeting of the Commissioner's Court. The motion was made by Cloe Spencer that Rex Varner be employed to haul Government Surplus Commodities from Mt. Pleasant, Texas, to the Rock Building in Gilmer, Texas, upon the condition that he present to the county judge proper proof that all vehicles used by him in the hauling of the commodities be insured in at least the amount of 5-10-5 liability insurance. His salary to be \$120.00. Motion seconded by Jim Shockey. The following members of the court voted in favor of this motion: Cloe Spencer, Jim Shockey and Welby K. Parish.

Motion was made by Jim Shockey that the county judge be given a secretary and that the county contribute One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per month as compensation to said secretary.
