WHEREAS, the compensation of the County Auditor for Upshur County, Texas, has heretofore been set at an amount not less than that paid the County Tax Assessor-Collector per year and has been approved by the Commissioners' Court for that amount;


Now, Therefore, I, Looney E. Lindsey, Judge, 115th Judicial District Court, the Court having jurisdiction in Upshur County, Texas, do hereby re-appoint Bruce Morris, Jr., a qualified person and citizen of Upshur County, Texas, as County Auditor of Upshur County, Texas; and he shall before entering upon the duties of said office, take and subscribe the oaths prescribed by law, as set forth in Article 1649, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, and enter into bond as therein provided, payable and conditioned as prescribed by law, and upon so qualifying, shall hold said office and discharge the duties thereof for a period of two years from the date he shall qualify under this appointment and until his successor shall be duly appointed and qualified.

The salary herein provided shall be paid in equal monthly installments at the end of each calendar month, as provided by law, and the said Bruce Morris, Jr. shall perform the duties prescribed for the office of the County Auditor and be subject to the provisions of law respecting his duties

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and tenure of office. This order shall be entered in the minutes of the 115th District Court of Upshur County, Texas, and be certified by the Clerk of said Court to the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, which shall cause the same to be entered in the minutes with appropriate order directing payment of the salary.

IN THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS  
IN REGULAR SESSION

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 12 day of September, 1960 at a regular term of the commissioner's court of Upshur County, Texas, a quorum thereof being present, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

WHEREAS the State Legislature of the State of Texas in house bill number 682, did convey to Upshur County, Texas eighty-one (81) acres of land located and situated in Upshur County, Texas, said land being fully described by metes and bounds as follows:

Being situated in Upshur County, Texas, amounting to approximately eighty-one (81) acres and a part of the A. Lumbrers Survey, Abstract No. 5, and being the remaining part of the land formerly used by the Dickson Colored Orphanage and now known and being used as the A & M Experimental Sweet Potatoe Farm, described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a stake in the WBL of right-of-way of U. S. Highway 271, said stake being 2.5 vrs East of the SEC Tract No. 2 in the original sub-division of the above-mentioned Orphan Home Property, a Sweet gum brs N 60 E 0.5 vrs;

THENCE With the WBL of U. S. Highway 271, around a curve to the left, S 10 deg 20 min N 36, and S 18 deg 20 min E 21 vrs to a concrete right-of-way monument;

THENCE S 16 deg E 777 vrs along the WBL of said highway to a corner in a branch, said corner being also in the SEL of the above mentioned 100 acre tract, and the NBL of a 100 acre tract in the Lumbrers Grant now owned by Joe Pickett;

THENCE West 540 vrs with the NBL of said Pickett land to a stake at the NWC of same, said stake lying in EBL of a 60.69 acre tract in said Grant now owned by Bob Wright;

THENCE North 108 vrs with the EBL of said Wright Tract to the NEC of same, a stake for corner from which a sweet gum brs N 70 deg E 4.2 vrs;

THENCE West 152 vrs with the NBL of said Wright Tract to the SWC of the above-mentioned 18.5 acre tract, and the SEC of a 37 acre tract in the name of Sam Ford;

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THENCE North 338 vrs with the NBL of said Ford tract to a stake at the N20 of same;

THENCE West 5.8 vrs with the NBL of said Ford tract to a stake at the CEC of Tract No. 1, in the sub-division of the above mentioned Orphan Home property;

THENCE E 1 deg 3 350 vrs to a stake at the SWC of Tract No. 2, of said Orphan Home sub-division;

THENCE N 09 deg 15 min L 465.3 vrs to the place of beginning, and containing 79.05 acres of land.

AND WHEREAS, on the 16th day of December, 1959 the commissioner's court of Upshur County, Texas did constitute and appoint D. T. Loyd, Aubry Williams, Jim Ferguson, Douglas Newsome, Dancil Marsh, and B. J. Hogg as an advisory committee for the purpose of developing a recreational center and facilities upon the aforesaid tract of land, and;

WHEREAS it is the desire of the commissioners court of Upshur County, Texas to authorize and empower D. T. Loyd, Aubry Williams, Jim Ferguson, Douglas Newsome, Dancil Marsh and B. J. Hogg with full power and authority to facilitate it's program of the development of it's park and recreational program upon the aforesaid tract of land for a period of ten (10) years.

THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that the said D. T. Loyd, Aubry Williams, Jim Ferguson, Douglas Newsome, Dancil Marsh and B. J. Hogg be and they are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to facilitate a program of development of a youth recreational center upon the aforesaid eighty-one (81) acre tract of land for a period of ten (10) years, within the keeping of the purposes intended and authority granted by the legislature of the State Of Texas in house bill 852 of the 56 legislature, revised statute 1959; and the said D. T. Loyd, Aubry Williams, Jim Ferguson, Douglas Newsome, Dancil Marsh and B. J. Hogg are hereby authorized to do all things necessary for the

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establishment of and facilitating of a youth development center upon the aforesaid eighty-one (81) acre tract of land, as fully and completely as this court may delegate, authorize and empower them so to do for a period of ten (10) years, with full power and authority to lease and sublet any buildings, concession stands, or any portion of the aforesaid eighty-one (81) acre tract of land during said ten year period for purposes not contrary to the limitations placed thereon in house bill number 862 and consistent to the proper development of said area for a youth recreational center; and the only limitations placed on said D. T. Loyd, Aubry Williams, Jim Ferguson, Douglas Newsome, Dancil Marsh and B. J. Hogg in the operation thereof shall be that they shall not make any use of any portion of said property for private gain or contrary to the interest of the development of a youth recreational center on said property; and all funds received by said D. T. Loyd, Aubry Williams, Jim Ferguson, Douglas Newsome, Dancil Marsh and B. J. Hogg in the operation of said property shall be used in the further development of a youth recreational center on said property and should the said D. T. Loyd, Aubry Williams, Jim Ferguson, Douglas Newsome, Dancil Marsh and B. J. Hogg fail and refuse to expedite the creation and building of a recreational center upon the aforesaid tract of land and begin the development thereof within six months from date, then and in that event, their authority to act in the premises shall be terminated.

Motion having been made and duly seconded that the aforesaid be and the same is hereby adopted as official acts of the commissioner's court of Upshur County, Texas. Said motion having been placed before said court and it having received a majority vote thereof for its adoption, the same is hereby in all things declared adopted.

That this Lease Contract and Agreement for grazing purposes, made and entered into by and between Upshur County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as Lessor, acting herein by and through the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, pursuant to an order of said Court heretofore duly made and entered upon the minutes of said Court and Roberta L. Richardson of Throckmorton, Texas, hereinafter referred to as Lessee, and in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements herein set forth,

W I T N E S S E T H:

1. That said Upshur County, Texas, hereby leases and lets to the said Roberta L. Richardson for grazing purposes only, and for a term of Five (5) years beginning the 1st day of June, 1962, and ending on the 1st day of June, 1967, the following described lands, to wit:

Lying in the Counties of Throckmorton and Baylor and State of Texas, and being 17,712 acres of land, more

or less, being the same land conveyed or patented to Upshur County, by the State of Texas, by Patent Numbers, to wit:

1st. Two (2) leagues of land granted to the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, by Patent No. 494, Vol. 11, dated July 5th, 1856, being Abstract No. 825, and to which patent and the record thereof in the General Land Office in Austin, Texas, reference is here made and said record is made a part hereof for full description of said land including field notes.

2nd. Two (2) leagues of land situated in Baylor and Throckmorton Counties, granted by the State of Texas, to the Commissioners' Court, Upshur County, by patent No. 772, Vol. 12, being Abstract No. 567, and to which patent and the record thereof in the General Land Office in Austin, Texas, reference is here made for further description and field notes and said record is made a part hereof for full description of said land. Said Four (4) leagues of land being known as Upshur County School Land and located in Throckmorton and Baylor Counties.

11. The rental for such Lease is and shall be the sum of ONE AND 26/100 DOLLARS (\$1.26) per acre per year, or a total of ONE HUNDRED ELEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE AND 60/100 DOLLARS (\$111,585.60) payable in five annual installments of equal amount, the

Five (5) installments are due on or before June 1, 1962, and June 1, 1963, 1964, 1965, 1966, 1967. All sums to be paid by Lessee hereunder are to be paid at Gilmer, Texas.

III. Failure upon the part of the said Roberta L. Richardson to pay any of said installments of rental when due hereunder shall entitle Upshur County, Texas, to forfeit the balance of the term of this Lease at the option of said County, Texas, acting by and through its Commissioners' Court. In such event and in case said land shall then be let for grazing purposes for the remainder of the term herein mentioned, then and in such event the said Roberta L. Richardson shall be liable for the balance, if any, remaining as unpaid difference between the rental provided for in this Lease and the amount for which said County may let such land for grazing purposes only in case of such forfeiture.

IV. All improvements heretofore made and now on the herein leased lands shall remain the property of Upshur County, Texas, and all improvements that may be made thereon by Lessee, her heirs and assigns, during the term of this Lease, shall become the property of Upshur County, Texas, upon the expiration of this Lease from any cause. This includes all fences, cross-fences, corrals and tanks, as well as any and all other improvements which may be now upon or may hereafter be made or

placed upon said lands, all of which are intended to be covered hereby in the same manner as if fully, definitely and particularly set forth, itemized and described herein.

It is understood and agreed, however, in this connection, that if any outside fencing is necessary upon said lands, then and in said event, Upshur County shall bear the reasonable cost thereof which may be deducted from any succeeding rental payment hereunder, by Lessee, Roberta L. Richardson, in the event she does such fencing or cause it to be done. Provided, however, that no such charge shall be made against Upshur County without first the approval for such fencing being given by the Commissioners' Court of said Upshur County. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in the event outside fencing is necessary upon said lands where same was caused by negligence of the Lessee, no expense shall be borne by the said Upshur County in improving same.

V. It is distinctly and expressly understood and agreed that Lessor, Upshur County, Texas, specifically reserves and excepts all oil, gas and other minerals in, to, underlying and that may be produced from the above described lands, and all such oil, gas and other mineral rights are specifically excepted and reserved to the Lessor County.

VI. The rights of Lessee hereunder shall be subordinate and subject to the rights of Upshur County, Texas, and its lessees and assigns, under any valid or subsisting lease or leases for oil, gas and other mining purposes, to mine, drill and explore the above described lands for oil, gas and other minerals and to produce, save, market and remove same therefrom, and to lay, erect, construct, build, maintain and operate such pipelines, telephones and telegraph lines, houses and structures as may be necessary and proper for the drilling, mining and exploring of said lands for oil, gas and other mineral purposes, producing, saving, marketing and removing the same therefrom.

In no event, however, shall any such mineral lessee from the Lessor County, or the heirs or assigns of such mineral lessee, have the right to use water on the above described lands from any water hole, wells, creeks, or tanks now on said land or which may be constructed thereon by Lessee, Roberta L. Richardson, or her heirs or assigns.

It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that Lessee shall have the right to sublet all or any portion of the above described premises for grazing purposes only, and that all the covenants, terms and conditions of this lease shall extend, apply to and firmly bind the heirs, successors and assigns of the ro-






